From the Pastor's Pen

Are we there yet? Those dreaded words we would ask as a child, the dreaded words parents may not have wanted to hear for the umpteenth time. In all my travels, I still can't get away from those words, "Are we there yet?" As much as I love to travel and go places, I get to that point where I'm just ready to be there already! Due to health reasons, she is not able to get out of the house much. And there they were, her and her husband. As she sat there in her wheelchair, she had her lap covered with fresh produce they had just bought. I stopped and visited for a few minutes. I said to them it was great to see them out and about. And their comment back was, "Yes, this is one thing we still enjoy and are still able to do."

As life changes and we have our own challenges, may we still be focused on the things we can do and not be discouraged by the things we can no longer do. Yes, life changes who we are, but it doesn't stop us from living!

Are we there yet? I'm ready for the next adventure today! Bring it on and let's see what's in store for us today!

Someone is Watching and Wondering



“I sure wish my garden looked like this,” I thought when I saw this picture. Alas, it doesn’t. Although I spend time working in the garden, it seems to be continuously sprouting new weeds. I pull, they come back, thicker, taller, and lusher than ever. Then there is the problem of dislodging good plants when I try to remove the weeds. They always seem to grow in and around my tomatoes, peppers, squashes and strawberries. Isn’t that also true of our lives. Although we try to live good lives, following the teachings of Jesus, we are too often lead astray. Yes, there are weeds in our culture, trying to pull us in so many directions, trying to choke our life that grows abundantly in the **true light which brings lasting peace and joy**. Of course I’m talking about Jesus and our relationship with Him.

In one of His parables Jesus says, “The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a man who sowed good seed in his field. While everyone was asleep his enemy came and sowed weeds all through the wheat, and then went off. When the crop grew and bore fruit, the weeds appeared as well.” Later the master’s slaves asked if they should pull the weeds. He replied: “No, if you pull the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until the harvest.” Of course Jesus was using this parable to describe the children of the evil one (the devil) who place temptations before the children of God each and every day. Jesus assures His followers there will be a judgment, and those who led others to sin will receive eternal damnation; those who turn to Him, repent, and seek guidance to live a Christ-like life will know God. They will “shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father.” **(Matthew 3:24-43)**

Reflecting on my own actions, I know I don’t always turn to Jesus and allow him to lead me. I want my own way, but I pray I’m not one of the weeds, metaphorically choking the life from another.

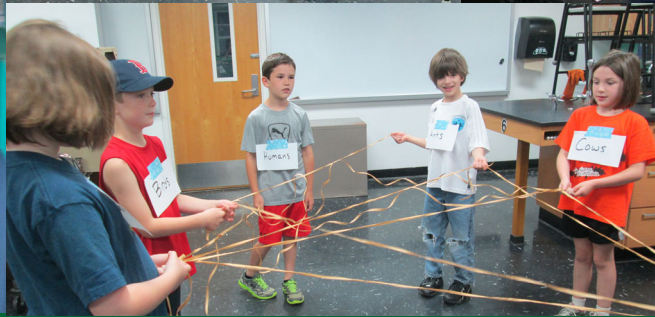
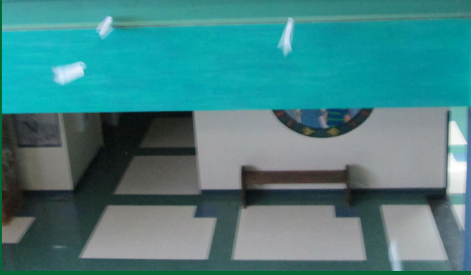

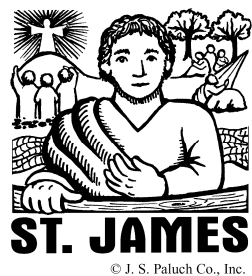
