Someone is Watching



I find it interesting how many images there are of Jesus. Each one different and expressing the unique viewpoint or understanding of the artist. Perhaps there is some accuracy in every representation, since He never sat for a portrait. I

think it also likely that images of Jesus come from the individual's knowledge of His words, His actions, His relationships, and their own relationship with Him. So why did I select this image; what does it say about my understanding and relationship with Jesus?

Today's words from Matthew's gospel, "But who do you say I am?" are challenging to me. Oh sure, I can quote the entire passage, as well as the teachings of the Church, but the real question seems to be "Who is Jesus to me, in my everyday, ordinary life?" I call Him by many titles: Lord, Messiah, Lamb of God, Good Shepherd, Rabbi/teacher, Paschal Lamb, Son of God, Christ, and so on; you get the idea. I wonder, however, if I dare use more intimate terms such as best friend, confidant, or my beloved? Is He the companion with whom I spend each day? Is He the last thought and image I have before falling to sleep at night? Do I share my inner most thoughts with Him? Do I trust Him to care for me, to guide, and to carry me through my brokenness?

Yes, this image reflects many of my thoughts, feelings, and understanding of Jesus. I see Him as strong, with a kind face and smile. His eyes are bright and full of life, but also filled with understanding and compassion. His appearance tells a story of being in nature, enjoying the sunshine, and never afraid of His father's creation. His smile is reassuring. I know I can tell Him my innermost thoughts, my fears, my darkest sin, and He will always respond with love. He will take my words into His heart, and He will lead me to healing. Who is Jesus to me? Yes, He is the Christ, the son of the living God, but He is also my best friend. He is my closest, faithful, trusted companion. He is my beloved. Giving myself to Jesus, accepting His love, and sharing it with my fellow human creatures brings great joy and peace into my life. His smiling face is aglow with His healing love. Who is Jesus to you, and what image appears in your mind? Your sister in Christ, *Sandy Gagnon*
