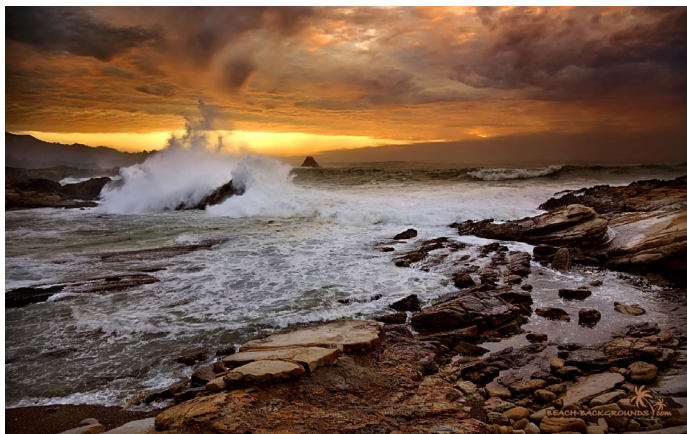

***Someone is Watching and Wondering***



Have you ever felt that your life was in the middle of a great storm? You weren't sure how or when it will end, or where it might take you. Perhaps you were frightened, disoriented, had trouble problem solving, felt lost, angry, numb, guilty, sad or alone. Were there even moments when you were just too tired to care? If you have experienced a recent loss in you life due to the death of a loved one or close friend, divorce, separation, loss of job, prolonged illness, loss of a pregnancy, or a reduction in income, I believe you may have known and experienced one or more of these feelings and emotions above.

During Lent, our St. James Community will begin a series of five-sessions entitled "*Sharing our Losses. . . A Journey of Hope, Peace, Joy and Love.*" The sessions will be offered both in the early afternoon (Wed-1:00-2:30) and evening (Tue 6:00-8:30). There will be time for prayer, scripture, sharing, and reflection. It is the hope of our facilitators that this journey will help your healing process, bringing new hope and inner peace. We know that God is the true healer, but we also believe that He works through each of us as we share His love with one another. We will provide a safe place and time for anyone who is hurting. As such, all sharing will be confidential and respectfully received. This is not an attempt to provide professional counseling, rather to share personal stories with others who are also experiencing loss. There will be time for quiet meditation, and listening to God's soft whisper and touch. The facilitators will be with you as guides, fellow travelers who, like you are searching for answers, new direction, and a continual rebirth of Christ's love in our hearts. We are all broken in some way. We all need Christ. We all need the hope, peace, joy and love that only a relationship with Him can provide.

Please prayerfully ask if you are being called to join this Journey, and watch the Bulletin for more details. We begin Feb 24th and 25th. Choose a time and day that fits your schedule.

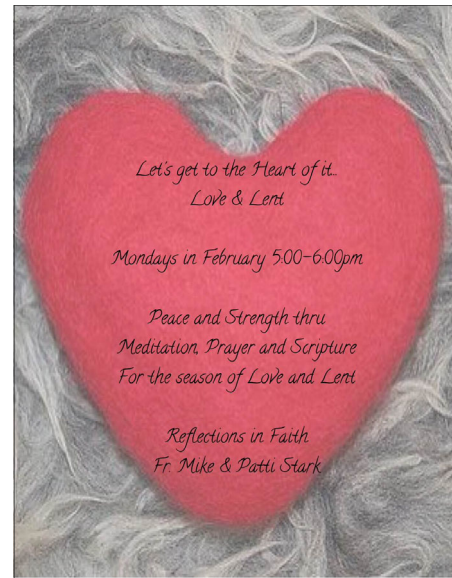

### January's Corporal Work of Mercy Shelter the Homeless

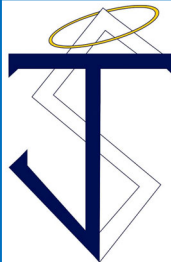
We were so thrilled with the great response to our hygiene items drive! I was especially impressed with the parents who told me that their children had been the ones to remind them that they needed to pick up some hygiene items. It's another sign that you are teaching your children to be compassionate and to empathize with those less fortunate. As we have read our stories this month--December, The Lady In The Box, Don't Laugh at Me--I have noticed how well they listened and how serious their faces were as the stories unfolded. February is just around the corner and with it our next Corporal Work of Mercy--Visit the Sick. We will be making both Valentine cards and Get Well cards with our students. The Valentines will go to Our Lady of Mercy as well as some area nursing homes, the Get Well cards will go with our Hospital Ministers as they make their rounds at the hospitals. Our parish will also be having a communal Anointing of the Sick on the weekend of February 21/22 at all the weekend Masses.

### Soup Suppers Beginning Soon!

A very beloved tradition here at St James, our Lenten Soup Suppers are hosted by our Religious Ed families for everyone in our parish to enjoy. We begin in the church at 5:45 for a short prayer service, and then move to the Social Hall for soups and hearty breads, brought by our students & their families. Each supper is sponsored by several grades; on that evening, the children in those grades provide the soups & breads, set up, serve & clean up. On the other evenings, they get to attend the supper as guests. These suppers are a lot of fun and raise a considerable amount of money for very good causes. Each year, we sponsor a charity and then ask anyone attending the supper that night to donate at least what you would have spent on supper that evening. This year we have selected the Urban Rangers program as our charity. This very worthy organization works with teens in the inner city of Kansas City to provide mentors, to encourage good grades, to foster service to the community done by the teens, and to make a difference in the lives of these at-risk young men. Originally an outreach program of St Louis parish, it has grown beyond being just a parish program and now has an impressive track record of successful & productive young men. 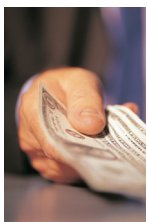
