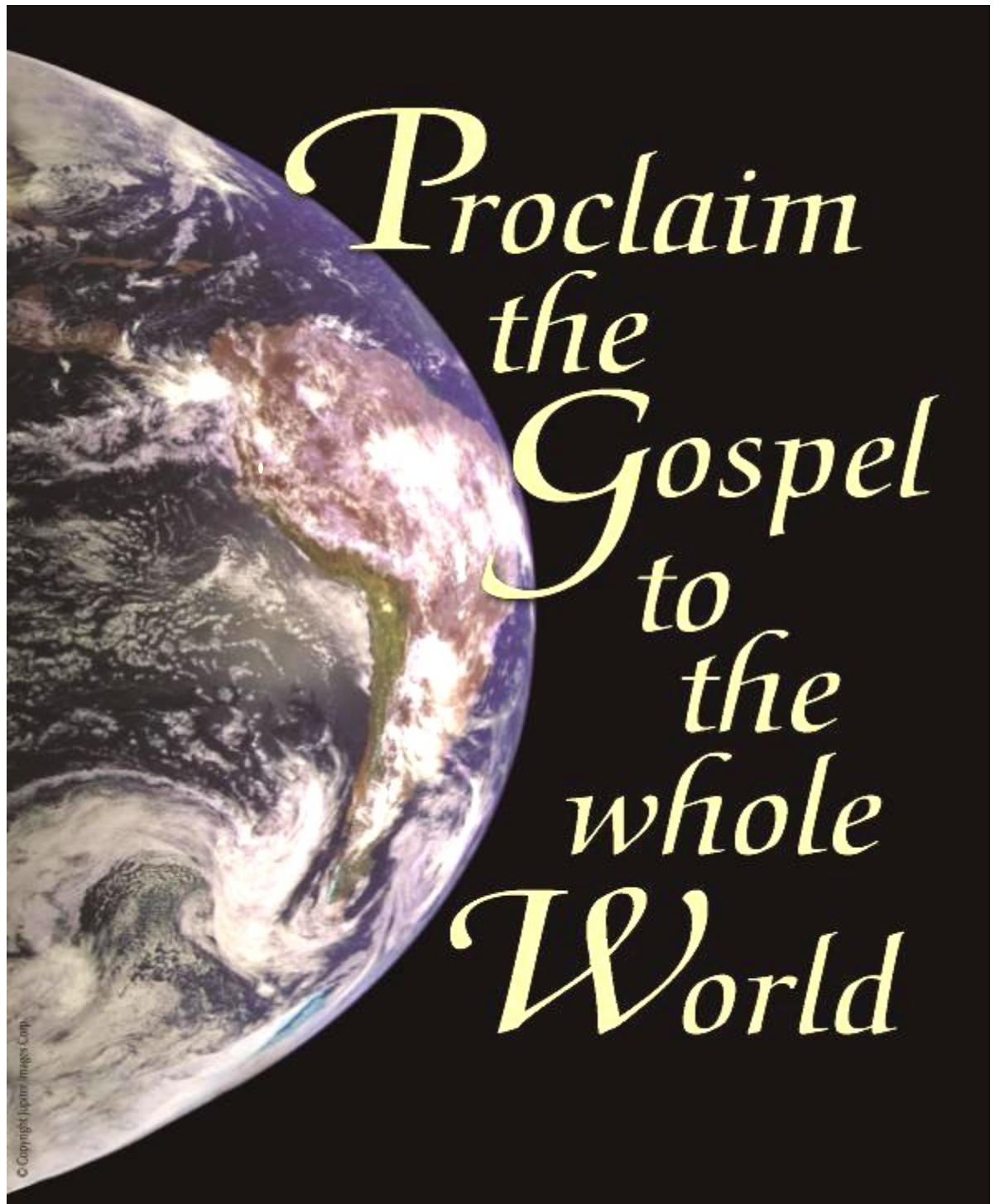

6. Reduced environmental impact through fewer lamps being produced; transported and eventually disposed of.

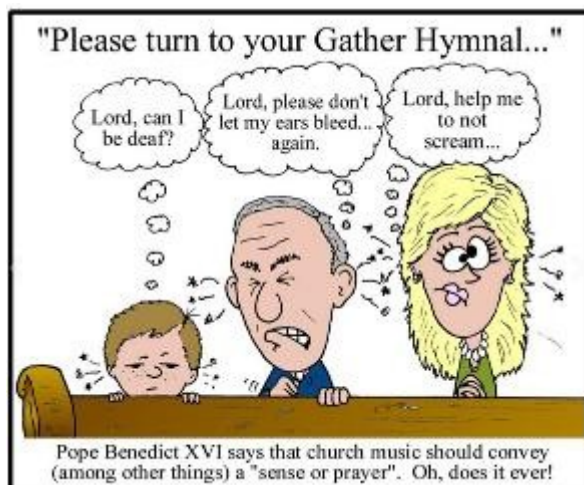

## *Someone is Watching and Wondering*



There have been a great many works of art depicting the Ascension of Jesus. When I discovered this particular picture, however, I was taken by its beauty and simplicity. It helped me understand the very implicit message of the ascension. "Jesus, the human man, returning to his *Abba*." There is no display of kingship, power, wealth, or glory, rather a sense of surrender, and the fulfillment of going home.

Over and over Jesus proclaimed the message of God's eternal, unending gift of love, expressed completely in returning that love through giving of ourselves in service to one another, especially the most vulnerable. Jesus willingly chose the Father's will by going to the cross so that humankind might be truly free. He gave himself, so that we might live in God's grace, and when he was totally emptied, his work finished, he returned to his heavenly Father.

At this time in my life I have a good deal of time to watch nature, read, and quietly reflect on the big question: "What next?" When I was young I had many dreams and hopes for my future: a loving husband, family, my own home, enough money to enjoy life without always scrimping, a fulfilling career. I've been blessed, and most of my dreams came to be. When I look ahead, however, there is a giant blank; no desires, dreams or goals. Yet, every morning, as I watch the beginnings of a new day unfold, I feel great peace and joy. I sense God's embrace and His voice saying "Your work is not finished." Strange as it may sound, I don't know what that work is, so I just embrace whatever the day brings, and I continue to believe. One day my work will be finished, and I hope I, like Jesus, will return to the loving hands of my heavenly Father who created me, and who has graced my life for so many years. This isn't to say my life is perfect, and all is peaceful. Quite the contrary, I often feel that my life is in turmoil, total chaos. When everything seems messy, I seem to get busy. I find so many things that need my attention. Sometimes my physicality is so great I simply drop from exhaustion, recoup, relax, and simply thank Him for pushing me forward. There is always another bend in the road, but I know He is waiting for me, just as He awaited the return of his beloved Son, Jesus.

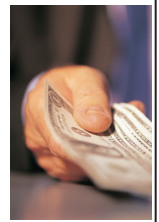
