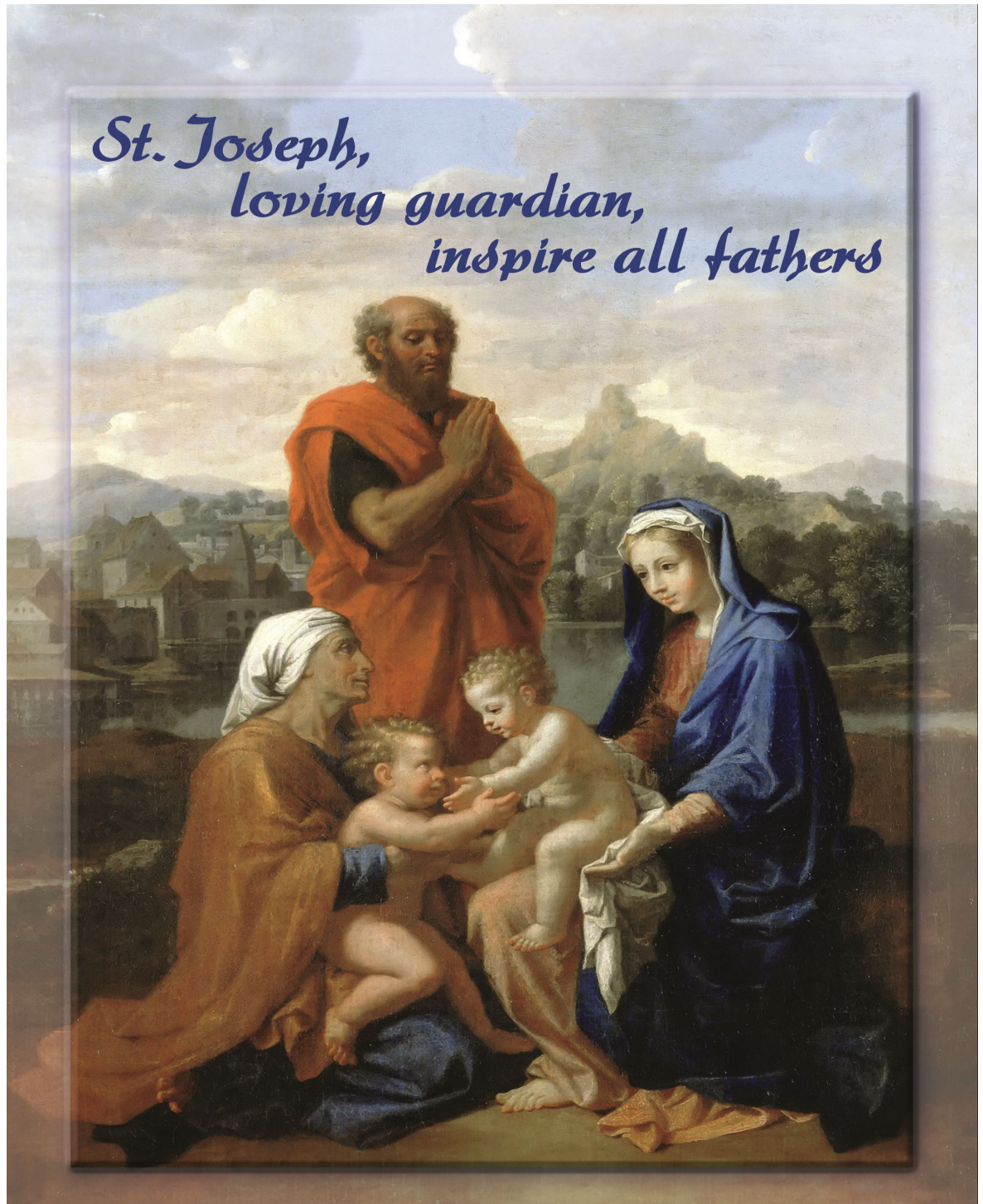

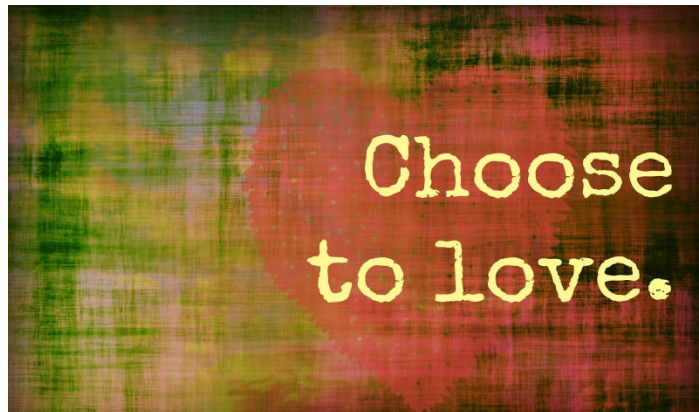

Someone is Watching and Wondering



A very wise man once told me **“We don’t fall in love, we choose to love.”** Frankly, I found this statement a bit confusing. I always thought love was something that happened to you, a feeling that overwhelms. Then I found this definition of *agape*: a love that is born of **choice**; one simply chooses to love regardless of feelings. A person may insult, injure, or humiliate; but *agape* love chooses to seek only the highest good for that person. It is sacrificial love, a love that is willing to die even for its enemies. (Practical Word Studies in the New Testament) It gave me pause to really think about my understanding of love.

Initially, we are attracted to another person by their physical appearance, an action or words spoken, and we make a decision to approach that individual and initiate a friendship. After a few interactions we decide to either end or deepen the relationship. Friendship may develop into greater trust and intimacy, through which we choose to share a life-long commitment. Over time we give ourselves in love to this person; a love that reflects Christ’s love for us. There are many reasons for the relationship to fade (eg distance, new vocation, death), but the love will endure.

I think the same may be said for any human being who comes into our life. Although we may remain strangers, never developing the intimacy of an enduring friendship, we are united by the love of Christ. It isn’t simply recognizing His love, or accepting His loved within ourselves. It is choosing an intimate relationship with Christ, so that we can reflect and share His love freely and openly with any of His children. It is a choice each of us must make. It isn’t an accident waiting to happen. It isn’t simply a feeling. It involves action. We cannot separate our love and relationship with Jesus Christ from the actions we take toward one another. In Jesus’ words we cannot love God and hate our brothers and sisters. As stated above, even if we are insulted, injured, or humiliated, we can choose to love. We can choose to seek their highest good. We can choose to follow the example of Jesus. It’s up to each of us.

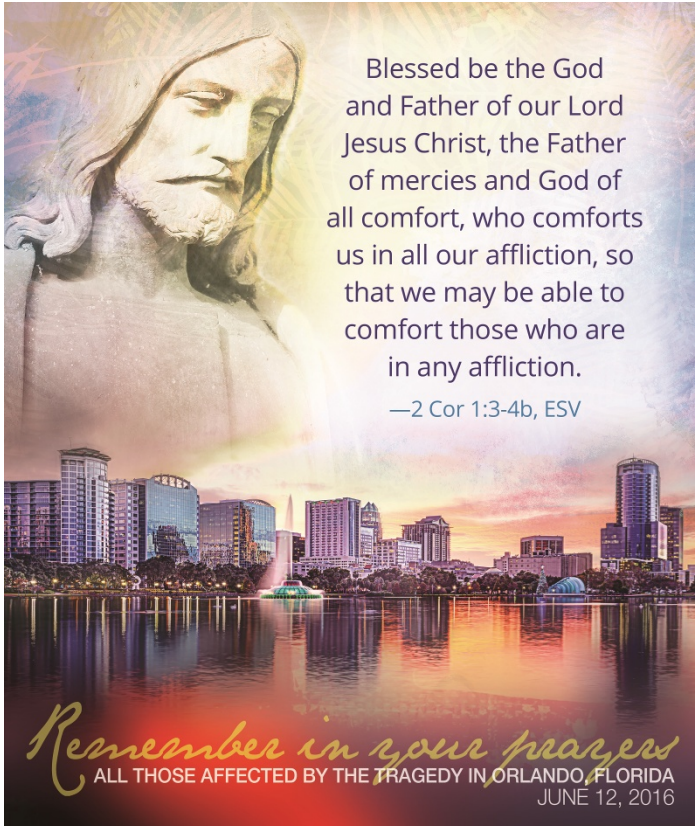

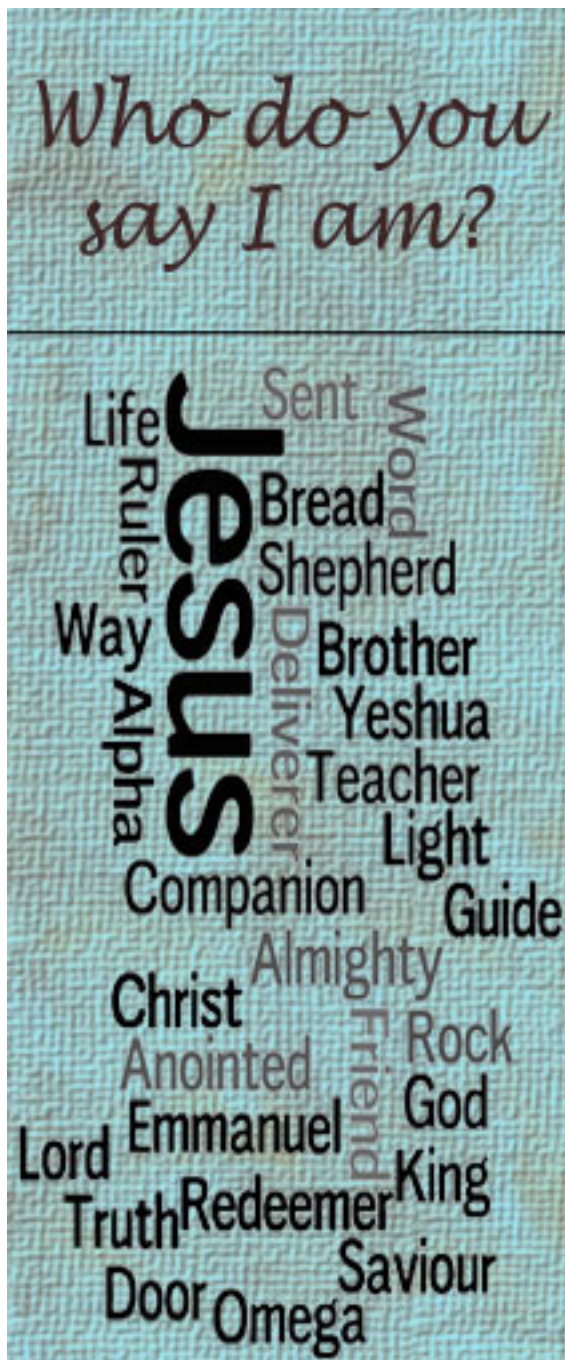
## Youth Group Happenings
