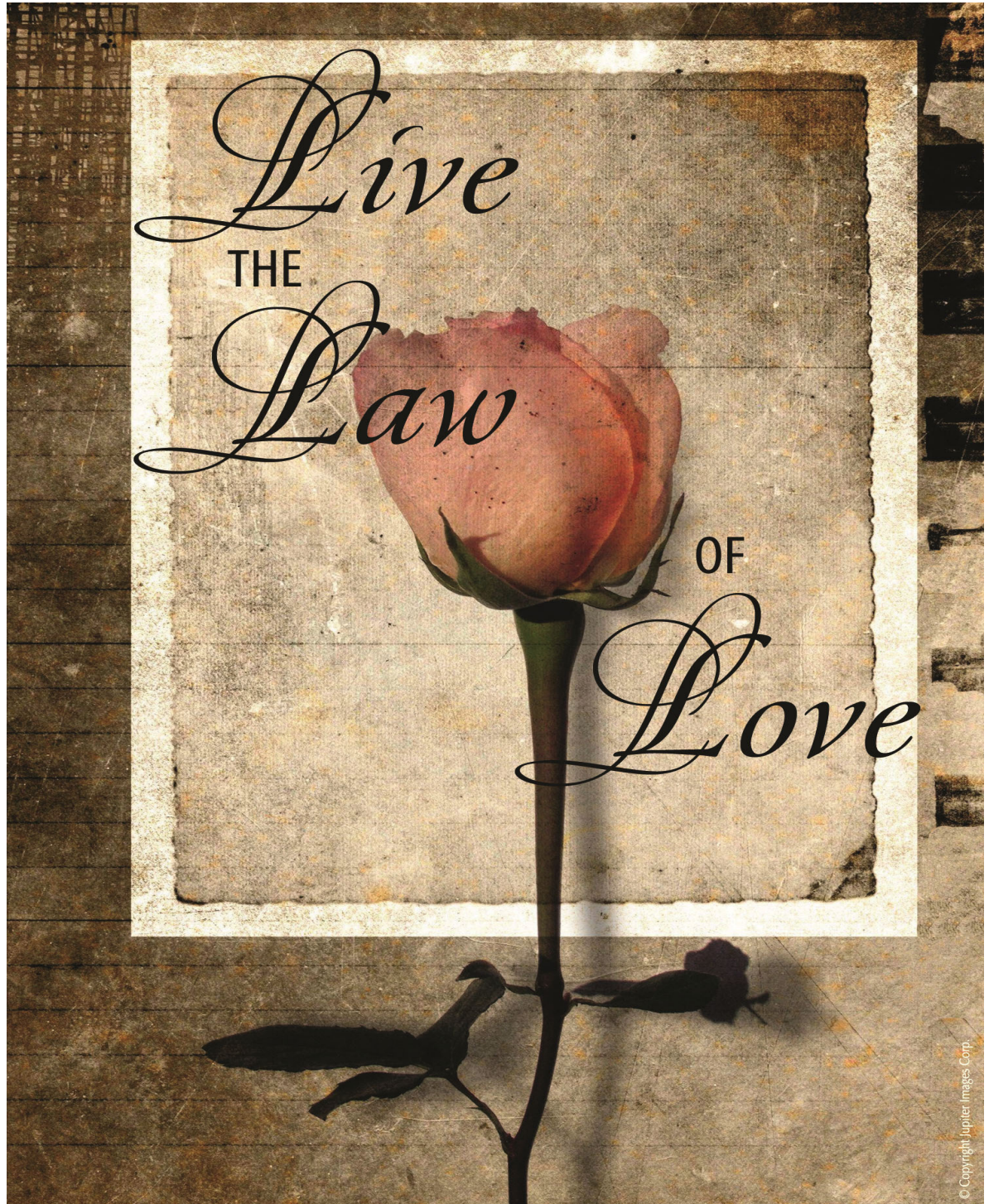

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



After reading today's Gospel, which I'm sure is familiar to most of you, I found myself focusing on the question, and subsequent answer of the scholar: "Who is my neighbor;" and "the one who showed mercy." Further, as I prepared to write this reflection, I found the above diagram. I replaced the central picture with one of myself, and began to write names of people important in my life, people I call friends. As you might expect those names closest to me were family members, then very close friends. I knew as I worked on my diagram, however, I was not responding to Jesus' story of the good Samaritan, nor was I necessarily a person showing mercy. Continuing, I decided to look at the definition of *mercy*. To my surprise it reads: "compassionate rather than severe behavior towards someone in one's power." This certainly put a different twist to my understanding. Although I always thought mercy was an act of compassion, I never connected such an act as towards someone over which I held power. My search widened with exploring *compassion*. Again, a surprise for me since Webster defines compassion as: "pity aroused by the distress of others, with the desire to help." Looking at my diagram, I realized that acts of mercy/compassion had little to do with the people I listed.

Allowing my mind to wander, I began thinking about people I have helped over the years. Once again, most were people I know and call close friends. OK, so perhaps I was beating myself up just a bit harshly, so I stopped focusing on my own actions and thought about actions within our parish. What came to mind immediately was the Advent Giving Tree. Every year, since becoming a parishioner, I have been amazed about our response in providing gifts for people, who are unknown to us, so that they may share the joy of Christmas. Yes, I have participated each year, and admittedly have received great joy as a result. I must admit, I always imagine the individual's face, with a smile, as they open the gift. Looking at the definition of mercy, I suppose I do have power in this case, because I have the funds available for the purchase, and a secret desire to share my love, as a very small reflection of Christ's love, with that individual. I might also add, it just feels good, the right thing to do as I once again prepare to celebrate the coming of Jesus into the world, and into my life. In truth I cannot think of a time when my actions were equal to the Good Samaritan, but I do believe every act of unselfish kindness and self giving shows mercy, and helps to spread the Gospel. In finishing my diagram there are now faces of nameless people, some quite different in appearance or culture than myself. What I know is Jesus is asking me to call all those who share my humanity friends, brothers and sisters in Christ.

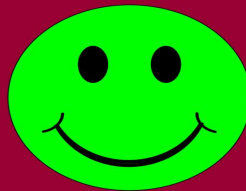

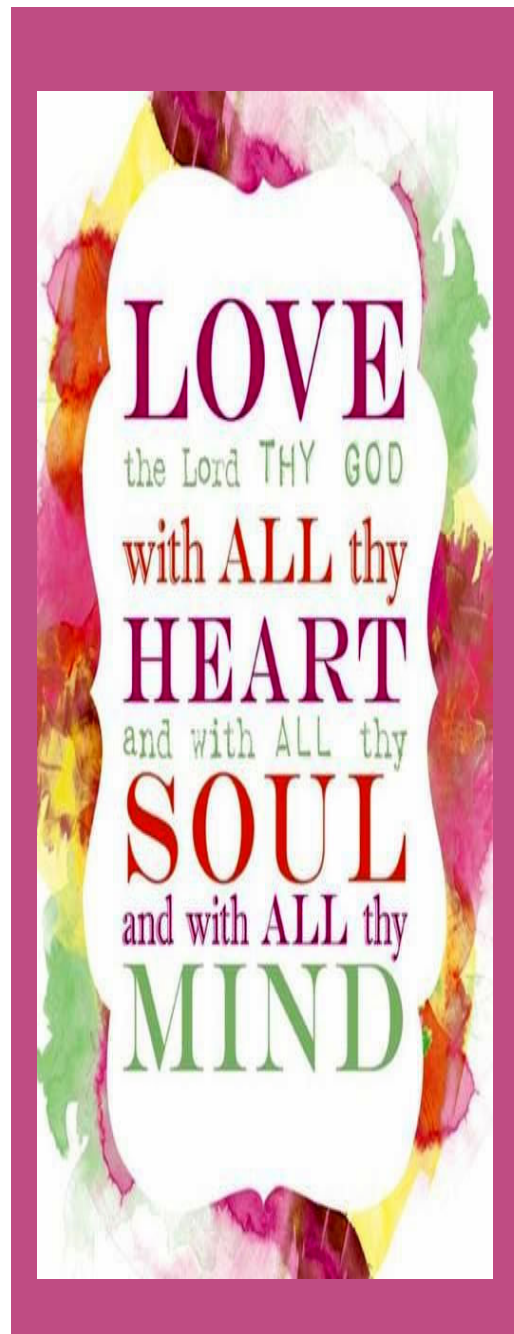
## Youth Group Happenings




