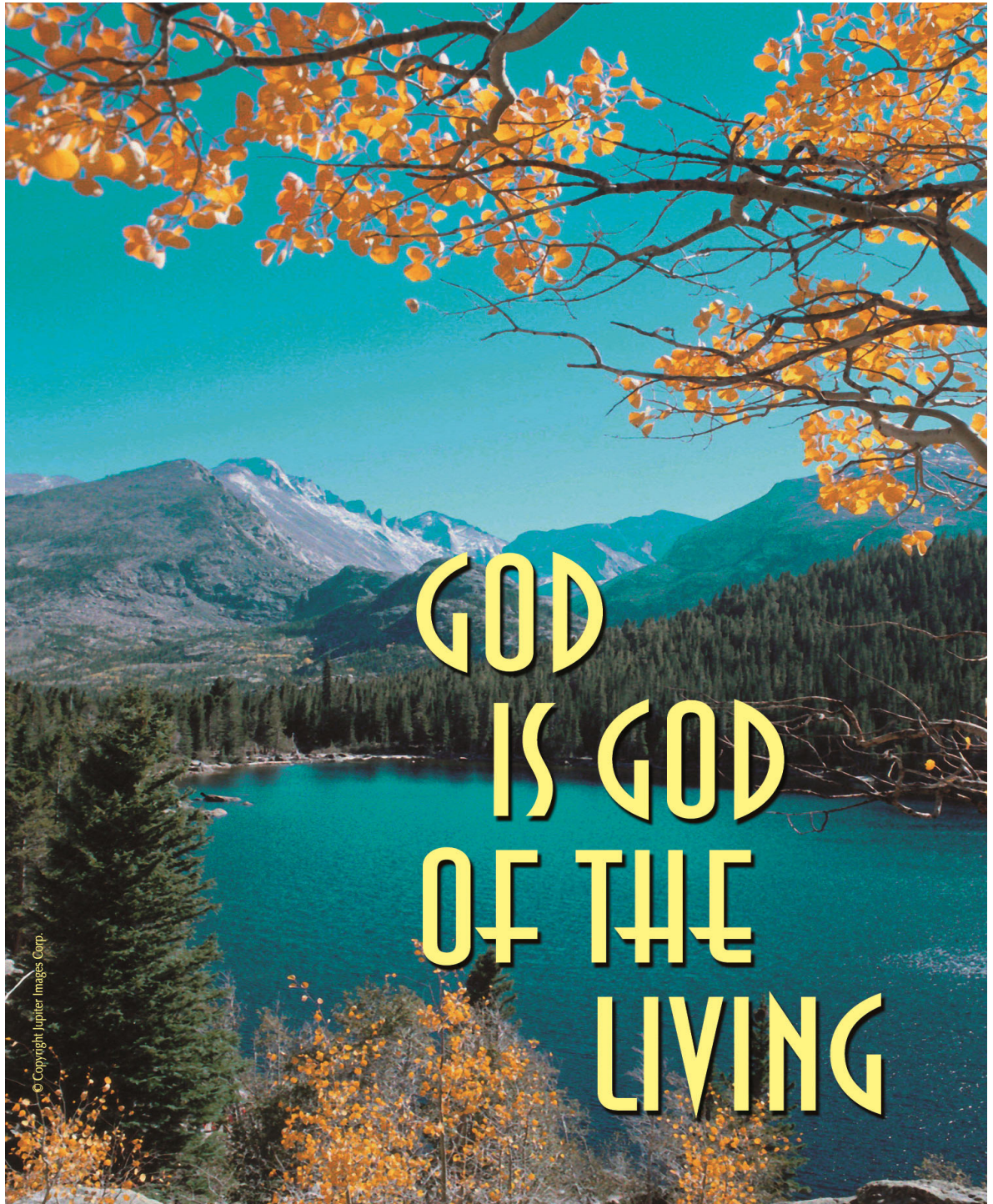

## From the Pastor's Pen

So you think you have been called? We speak of listening to God's call in our life and finding ways to respond to that call. We speak of men and women being called to serve as religious brothers, sisters and priests. This week we celebrate National Vocations Awareness Week. It is a week dedicated to talking about vocations, our call and how each of us has responded to that call in our life.

As I have had the opportunities to speak with those discern and question God's call in their life, one thing that I keep coming back to is how do we know God's voice in our life? How do we know it is God calling us and not just some random voices we are hearing? This past weekend, I along with 300 other vocation directors of both men's and women's religious groups gathered for our Bi-Annual NRVC Convocation. The National Religious Vocation Conference began in 1988 as a merger of the National Conference of Religious Vocation Directors (NCRVD) and the National Sisters Vocation Conference (NSVC). Today the NRVC has an annual membership of over 900 women and men representing over 350 religious institutes, both national and international, most of whom are vocation ministers for religious congregations.

Our two keynote speakers were Fr. Kevin O'Brien, S.J., Jesuit School of Theology and Ms. Sherry Weddell, Catherine of Siena Institute. Both of them spoke of discernment and hearing the call. But more importantly first having the experience of Jesus in our life. We can teach all we want, but without that personal experience and connection, all else may not connect.

Our theme for Convocation 2016 was "Awakened by the Spirit: Called to Discipleship." The theme draws on Pope Francis' invitation to those in consecrated life to "Wake up the World." Once awakened by the Spirit, we are compelled to move outward and proclaim the Good News. We know that as disciples, the Spirit moves in and through us and God "is able to accomplish far more than all we ask or imagine, by the power at work within us" (Ephesians 3:20).

We continue to seek vocations, and invite others to hear God's call in their lives, but most importantly to invite others to have that personal experience of Jesus. Where do we find that encounter?

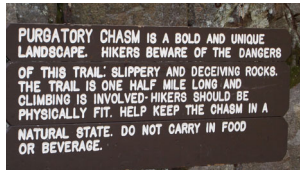

## Someone is Watching and Wondering

The month of November is the time each year when we pause as Church to remember the dead, and to reflect on our understanding of the "Communion of Saints." The Catechism states "the Church is a Communion of Saints. . .the 'holy things' by which 'the unity of believers, who form one body in Christ, is both represented and brought about,' [and] the communion of 'holy persons' in Christ." (960-61) This communion of the faithful includes "pilgrims on earth [church militant], the dead who are being purified [church suffering—Purgatory], and the blessed in heaven [church triumphant]" (CCC, 962) Fellow pilgrims on earth are all around, so it isn't necessary to form a mental image. I'm also confident that mental images of Heaven and Hell come readily to mind. However, what about an image of Purgatory.

I am a very visual person, so after thinking a bit I searched the internet. I quickly discovered a State Reservation established in 1919, in Massachusetts, aptly called *Purgatory Chasm*. Here is a posted warning placed at the beginning of this chasm. This descriptive warning fit my simple concept of Purgatory, the "final purification of [those who die in God's grace and friendship, and are] "still imperfectly purified." (CCC 1030-1) As all hikers know, sometimes a trail is dangerous, containing many obstacles, even though it may be quite short. There may be steep slopes, stone outcrops, or damp, slippery areas. Each hiker must be physically fit for the adventure. Perhaps the final purification before heaven requires preparation, such as an acknowledgement of our sinfulness, strong faith, trust in God's love and forgiveness, and a strong desire to be with God for all eternity. I am not a theologian, these are simply my thoughts. I know God will never reject any of His children, yet I may choose to reject God. In contrast, however, to truly love and serve God, I must be prepared to



follow where ever He leads me. This photo is of another place in the USA called Purgatory. Following this path can certainly be dangerous and requires preparation. I know first hand. Too tired, and too inexperienced I attempted to ski a similar slope with a disastrous outcome. Two surgeries and six months of therapy were required before I could walk without assistance. However, I was one of the lucky ones. I survived without any permanent disability, only arthritis where the injury was sustained. The inclusion of this picture wasn't simply to fill space. Instead, this picture is another reminder that all of life's adventures require training and preparation. Being a follower of Jesus is no less strenuous, and surrendering to Him is a life-long process. I cannot imagine what it is like to live forever with Christ, to see Him as He is, face to face. However, what I do know is that I want to prepare, as much as possible in this life, so I will be ready for my final purification.
