## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Love is one word in the English language that is overused and often misunderstood as a sentimental feeling or salutation. Confusion regarding the word is not eliminated with a quick search for its definition. The word love can be a noun, a verb, or an adjective. (The term even represents a score of zero in tennis.) Admiration, affection, attraction, and desire are just a few of the synonyms for love. This word is used on a daily basis by most humans, and there are numerous references to love in Holy Scripture. Two passages which come to mind are: 1 John 4:8 that states "God is Love," and John 3:16, "for God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." I studied this first passage as an adult taking a graduate course entitled *The New Testament* and the second passage was introduced to me as a young child, memorizing scripture in Sunday School. Now, it seems a bit odd that my understanding of God was actually a love of the man Jesus. I didn't understand anything about God's nature or His love so beautifully expressed in the Hebrew Scriptures. In fact, although I proclaimed "One God in three Persons," the Trinity was unreal for me, and too difficult to grasp. Only Jesus made sense and seemed loving. It took a long time before I understood that the Trinity is more about self gift and relationship, and less about the distinct attributes of Father, Son, and Spirit.

Surprisingly my concept of self-gift correlates with one of the dictionary definitions for love: "self-sacrificing loyal concern that freely accepts another and seeks his/her good." The Greeks very wisely have several words which are translated as love in English, with *agape* the Greek word that corresponds to this definition. For me, *agape* is the word which describes God. Our very existence is God's gift of love, pure and unselfish. As such our lives should be a reflection of His love. An infant has no concept of hatred, manipulation, morality or sin. Our relationship to newborn children, likewise, is one of acceptance, nurturing provider, and loving protector. It is easy to accept an infant as God's beloved child. Unfortunately, life's experiences may leave scars which alter our outlook towards other people. It becomes easier and easier to forget that all we have, all we are is because of God's love. His *agape* is universal, ever present, and given as grace to all people, regardless of cultural status or lifestyle.

This fourth Sunday of Advent we are reminded to love as God loves, to respect and care for all His children, to cherish and protect everything which He provides, and to transform the world.
