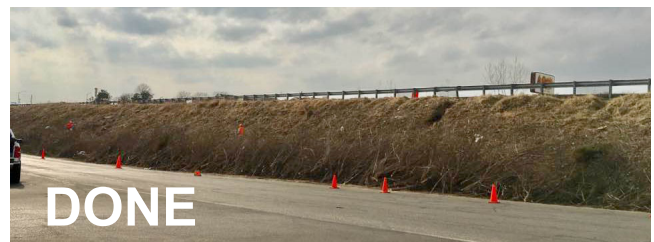

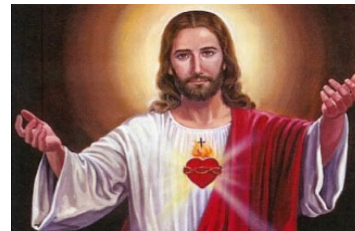

We begin this psalm commanding our whole being to bless the God who forgives our sins, heals our ills, and redeems us from destruction. Rather than the justice our human hearts so readily understand and measure out, our God offers us mercy far beyond the horizon of our comprehension.

Such attitudes and actions describe the holiness of God. This divine holiness is not an attribute but a state of being: God **IS** holy. And we are to be holy as God is, perfect as God is. **Someone is Watching and Wondering**



Last Sunday I attended a concert given by the Liberty Community Chorus, entitled "Love is Here to Stay." I must applaud the Chorus for an outstanding performance. They began with I Corinthians 13 pre-

sented in a beautiful choral rendition which I must confess I had never before heard. The concert continued with a wide variety of musical arrangements around the theme of love. Some selections were taken from sacred music, others from popular musicals, and one written by Steven Foster was actually used as campaign music for Abraham Lincoln. All in all, the time spent was most enjoyable, sometimes thought provoking, and once or twice brought tears to my eyes. The chorus performed many of my favorites songs, yet the closing selection really hit a cord deep within me.

This final selection was a piece written for Bill & Ann Grace in 2016 by Jake Narverud. Since I cannot recreate the music here, I will let the lyrics speak for themselves.

*When all alone, and lost within the silence, I hear a faint and far off distant sound.  
A voice cries out, from deep with me, longing, to join in song.  
And then, in peace, I'm fond: O sing my soul!  
O sing my soul!

In all the earth, I've found no greater beauty than when we're bound by harmony in song.  
I feel at home when I hear the music calling, my heart if full, I know where I belong.

In steadfast love, I search for hope within me and choose to make the goodness of men known.  
And so with joy I life my heart to dream for all the world, a song to sing.  
Sing my soul, O sing my soul!*

For me, these words so beautifully describe the love of God. The words capture the peace and hope that can only come through surrendering and resting in His never ending love. I hope you enjoy this sharing. Have a hope filled week.

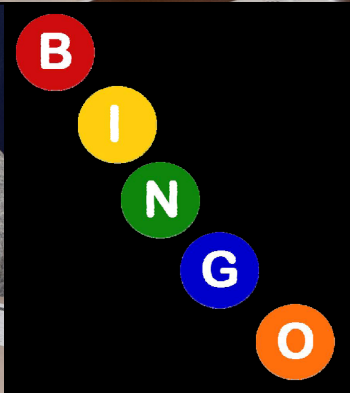

### To Help Someone In Need

*"For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me." (Matthew 25:25-36)*

One of our catechists has been working with the Don Bosco Center's ESL school that teaches English, primarily to refugees and immigrants. She has found that among these refugee families, there is a great need for simple household goods. They come here with very little, and often without warm clothes and blankets. These families are primarily from much warmer climates than we have here.

Our parish office has been organizing a small effort to collection donations of things that they could use. She noted that they are very grateful for any donations and that they are very respectful and careful to take only the barest of essentials so that others may share.

So if you have extra blankets or coats, or household goods (like dishes, pots/pans, etc) that you don't need or were planning to donate, you are welcome to bring them to the parish office during the week, or to Religious Ed during class time, and we will see that they get down to the Don Bosco Center for distribution. Large items, like furniture, are too difficult logistically for this, so you can continue to donate those to Hillcrest Hope – just take them to the loading dock at the side and they'll be happy to unload them for you!
