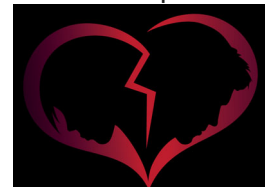
## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Continuing with my understanding of Lent as a time of healing, I wanted to share a fifth step which has become very significant in my life. The fifth step is learning to "see myself as God sees me/accept my humanness." I have previously written on this topic but I think Lent is a good time for re-emphasis as part of the healing process during these forty days.

*"O Lord, you have searched me and known me.  
You know when I sit down and when I rise up;  
You discern my thoughts from far away.  
You search out my path and my lying down,  
and are acquainted with all my ways.  
Even before a word is on my tongue,  
O Lord, you know it completely.  
You hem me in, behind and before,  
and lay your hand upon me.  
such knowledge is too wonderful for me;  
It is so high that I cannot attain it."* (Psalm 139:1-6)

These words of the psalmist beautifully express what I mean by seeing myself as God sees me. The psalmist expresses a calm yet awed trust that God knows everything about him and loves him in spite of any shortcomings, failures, or sinfulness. If I am truly, completely honest, I know there are times when I don't like myself very much. I can readily elucidate my perceived, as well as real, faults with disdain. For instance, I carry too much weight, I have too many wrinkles, my hair is always a mess, I lose my temper, and I express my beliefs too forcefully. Actually the list is quite long, but I will not bore you further, as I'm sure you get the idea. The incarnation of Jesus, however, reminds me that God loved His human creatures so much that He became one of us. Jesus became our example, teacher, and guide so that we might understand how to be fully alive, fully human, and what it means to be daughters and sons of the Lord. If I can learn to see myself in His light, learn to change where I fall short of His teachings, and embrace His love for me, then I begin to see myself as He sees me. With His eyes I begin to understand the goodness of all mankind, including myself. Things I cannot change don't matter but things I can change need to be attended to.

## Girl Scouts Volunteer at Synergy Services

Synergy Services strengthens the individual, family and community through crisis intervention, shelter, counseling, advocacy and education." They help children, youth, women and families and our scouts believed this is important and wanted to help. We began by participating in "One Homeless Night", learning about the 2,000 homeless youth of Kansas City. We built a cardboard house, ate chicken soup, welcomed a great speaker from Synergy, and slept outside to honor those youth who do it on any given night.

This experience really got the troop thinking - can WE make a difference here? We organized a clothing drive, just our families, friends and a few neighbors. We washed, sorted and bagged the clothes and were able to bring about 60 bags of clothes for babies through adults.

We delivered the clothes to the women's shelter in hopes they will help families as they rebuild their lives.

We toured the new Safe Haven facility just for kids – more about the kids in a second. We cooked, and served dinner and brunch for women and children at Synergy's shelter and really enjoyed playing bingo and play dough too!

We realized they needed help organizing, so we worked on restoring their art room and organizing supplies and toys. This frees up room for the kids to be kids in a tough situation.

Another big project we worked on was furnishing the new kids shelter with some of themed tubs for the kids. Each tub has a theme, like beach/ocean, farm animals, superheroes and , and have fun. We gathered new and gently used toys from our families, friends, neighbors and even people from our church. Seems like others joined in our project to help the kids in need too when they heard about our hope too when they heard about our hope to help fill a need. Each tub held toys, games and art supplies within the theme, enabling the kids to create stories and have fun.

We hope our projects help the kids and families! It's been wonderful getting to know them a little, but even more importantly we know we CAN each make a difference in our world.
