Do You Know?

The November 2016 Hail Storm damaged all our roofs. The insurance settlement will enable us to replace each of them. Starting Monday, May 8, the job was begun. The flat roof above the gym is being replaced (upgraded to TPO) first; they will then move to the roof above the middle school.

The timeline calls for both to be replaced in six working days, weather permitting.

The balance of our roofs are shingled. The parish office was completed two weeks ago and the Church, Social Hall, and the pitched roof of the school will follow.

Weather permitting (that's a wild assumption), the work will be completed by the second week in June.

An added bonus – our new Church and all the older buildings will be covered for the next generation of "Saints".

Someone is Watching and Wondering



I know that today is a time to honor mothers and to reflect not only on the mothers who raised us but also on all those individuals who have been mother figures in our lives. For me, however, as I remember these many nurturing people in my own life I also see the opportunities I was given which formed and influenced how I view life and the world in which I live.

As a young child I was taken to the library and encouraged to not only read, but to explore many different and unknown worlds. My grandmother taught me to create pictures with thread, while my sister and mother let me help with baking goodies and preparing family meals. As a family we visited different cities and states, went swimming in lakes, saw Native Americans dancing, celebrated holidays with extended family, and shared many adventures. I always had a warm bed, clean clothes to wear, food to eat, and medical care when I was ill. I lived in a safe neighborhood, attended good schools and our neighborhood church, sang in the choir, became a Girl Scout, and made friends with whom I shared secrets and good times. Looking back now I realize that although life wasn't perfect or always what I planned, my childhood was blessed.

Today, however, I view our world with less sheltered eyes. I realize there are many whose childhood experiences are vastly different from mine. Even in the United States, one of the wealthiest countries in the world, there are children who do not have access to libraries, books, quality schools, vacations, safe neighborhoods, adequate food, shelter, medical care, or dreams. You can easily check the statistics for the number of at risk children with an internet search. Although the numbers are overwhelming, perhaps what is even sadder is that the parents of these children love them and are doing the best they can. When I look at my children and grandchildren, with so many opportunities, I know they are blessed, but what about all these other children?

Simply stated, every human being is loved, blessed, and never abandoned by God. However, it is our responsibility to do what ever we can to care for those who are struggling to obtain the basic necessities of life; seeking opportunities to live in safety, to provide for their children, to worship without fear. St. Pope John XXII wrote in *Pacem in Terris*, that the world community is called to "tackle and solve problems of an economic, social, political or cultural character which are posed by the universal common good." This statement does not simply apply to governments, world leaders, institutions or the wealthy. This statement applies to each of us. It is truly our responsibility to work toward the common good for all people. Every child, every human has the right to education, protection from abuse, medical care, a decent place to live, healthy food, love and security. It is true, "Our rights = Our future" and we are all called by Jesus to insure these basic rights for all people. Thank you to all mothers who defend, protect, and stand up for all children. May God bless you and continue to work through you.

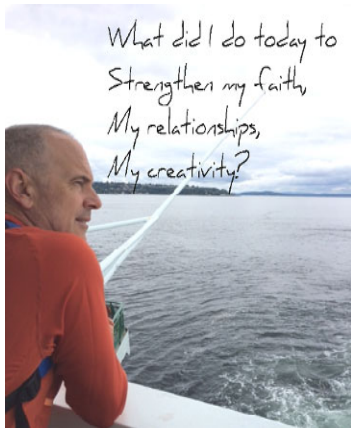
Month of May Dedicated to Mary, Mother of God

Raising Prayerful Kids

When was the last time you experienced awe? What made that event different from your daily routine? I suspect it came because you were paying attention. When you cultivate awe by paying more attention, you come to realize that God is watching you with love.



Here are some ways to develop your family's sense of awe.

- 1. Take an attitude of respect.** You can signal your respect toward God by getting down on your knees, praying with open hands, or going to church services early and sitting in silence.
- 2. Follow a child around.** Observe how delighted this child can be with the world. Watch that child's face and learn to feel awe once again.
- 3. Add some silence to your life.** Let the silence restore your ability to appreciate the beauty of God's bounty.
- 4. Suspend your disbelief.** Start your day by saying, "If I did believe that God could touch my life in special ways today, how would I live?" Then act as if that, in fact, is true.
