## Do You Know?

### Important Information About the Parish Hall Partitions

Last September St. James invested close to \$20,000 for the purchase and installation of the Parish Hall partitions. The purpose of that investment was and is:

- (1) To allow multiple groups a clean and professional environment for meetings or small class sessions. Space is always a problem in our growing community.
- (2) To provide minimum security in a professional environment for very small children to be contained, under adult supervision, in a smaller area. PBJ and nursery etc.

### Please Be Aware that neither of these utilization's require locking the partitions.

When properly aligned the partitions will close securely and easily with no need to apply the locks. If the partitions are locked and you are not scheduled (critical dates) you probably do not need to get in. If you have that need, use a dime on the lock, NEVER a screw driver or similar device. The lock has a half-moon receptacle on the outer side.

Two of these locks have been damaged in the past weeks by using a screwdriver. Muscle is never the way to handle the lock or the partitions. We will ensure that groups using the facilities after hours through critical dates are alerted.

Hello friends! So many of you have been asking about my health, so I thought it would be easier if I wrote a little update this week in my column. As most of you know, on April 4th I had gastric sleeve surgery. Since my surgery I've already lost 78lbs. And I must say, I feel great! I have more energy. My back doesn't hurt and plus I'm sleeping much better.

For my next step, this is what I know. I go back to the liver doctor at the beginning of August to re-evaluate my liver. There are two outcomes possible. First one could be that because of the weight loss, the progression of the liver disease has slowed. If that's the case I won't need a liver transplant YET. Or option 2, the liver disease is still progressing rapidly and then I'll be put on a transplant list.

Your continued support and prayers are greatly appreciated and I've certainly felt them these fast few months!

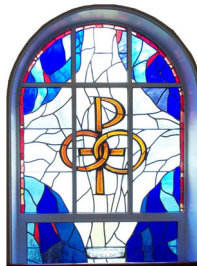
### Children's Choir

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



The Catechism of the Catholic Church states the "sacraments are sacred signs, instituted by Christ, to give grace." Sacraments, therefore, do something; God gives grace to His creation. Bernard Cooke in his book *Sacraments and Sacramentality* states "The grace given in sacramental liturgy is, at least for baptized Christians, a needed resource" for experiencing a life fully lived in Christ. Grace literally touches everything in our lives; it pervades everything we are and do. Cooke refers to "uncreated grace" as "the reality of God who in the act of self-giving. . . transforms and heals and nurtures our human existence." Sacraments transform our understanding of what it means to be human, change our human experiences, and provide a special avenue of insight into the reality of God. Our image of God develops through our relationships with one another. In fact, the sacramentality of human friendships and love most clearly reveals His love outpoured through grace.

Marriage and marriage rituals have been recorded and passed down through every civilization, yet there is something unique about a sacramental marriage. To begin, a covenant in the biblical sense refers to an agreement between God and His people. In other words, God initiates and the people respond, sealing the covenant with an action. In a sacramental marriage the couple respond to God's grace through sharing His unconditional love with one another. The words of the marriage vows reflect the reality of the covenant the couple make: "for better or for worse, in sickness and in health, 'til death do us part." They will love, cherish, protect, provide, and forgive one another. They will be honest, faithful, and sincere. They will give without any thought of receiving, allow the other to reach their full potential without jealousy, and always put the other first. Their shared nurturing will become a reflection of God's abundant tender care.

Whenever I attend a marriage in our Catholic tradition I recognize that I am a witness to God's transforming grace. I hear the couple pledge their love and fidelity and I pray for the life they are beginning, a union sealed and centered in God's love. I pray that they may feel His strength and healing as they encounter daily trials, disagreements, and decision making. I pray that they may always feel the love of friendships and community. I pray that they find support from our Church, and that doubts between them are quickly healed. I pray that their faith remains strong, even when they question where God is leading them, and I pray for the families they bring together and the family they will build.

For a marriage to be sacramental, a witness to God's divine presence, means that "human love does more than make it possible for us to trust that God love us. . . God is revealing. . . divine self-giving in love." (B. Cooke, *Sacraments and Sacramentality*) It is our awareness of being loved, both by God and by another, that leads us to reach the full potential of our humanity. God has truly blessed each of us with being human.

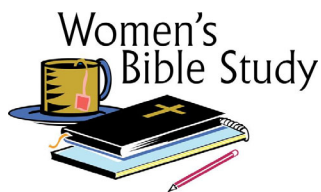

These two saints are the founders of the See of Rome, through their preaching, ministry and martyrdom there.

Peter, who was named Simon, was a fisherman of Galilee. Jesus gave him the name Cephas (Petrus in Latin), which means 'Rock', because he was to become the rock upon which Christ would build His Church.

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church.

In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Sts. Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood."
