From the Pastor's Pen

November is the month of remembrance as we celebrate All Saints and All Souls and other days of remembrance. I love to take that trip down memory lane and recall the many wonderful memories of the family farm. Someone once commented saying "You would love to be back on the farm wouldn't you?" To which I replied "Yes! I would love to be back on the farm – the farm that was there 25 years ago with all the people, not just the empty buildings that it is today." The family farm is more than just the buildings. What made the farm so great was all the people I got to know and love. Everyone from grandparents to aunts and uncles, great aunts and uncles and all the cousins. Yes, I loved being outdoors and all the work, but I cherished more the relationships. Buildings and machinery could be replaced but not the people nor the memories.

In different ways, it was also the place where faith was rooted and challenged. My grandfather always spoke of the God Lord almighty, especially when a storm was brewing, every meal began with a prayer, and many times as we were harvesting a fist was waved at an approaching storm or dust cloud or both hands were raised in praise that we were finished! God was a part of a day before I ever realized it.

This weekend we celebrate National Vocation Awareness Week. It is a time to reflect upon the call of God in our lives. It is a time to consider where is God calling me and might it be to service in the church as a priest, deacon, brother or sister? Is it a call to religious life? Is it a call to married life? Is it a call to single life? Many times when we talk about vocations it focuses only on religious life. Sometimes we forget it is God calling each of us to.

Your vocation is God's unique invitation to you in which a free response is expected. Your response is not a one time "yes" or "no" answer, but a life-long process, a journey of faith. You do not *have* a vocation; you discover how you *are* your vocation as you journey through life led by the Spirit.

Where is the Spirit calling us today? What is the Spirit speaking to my heart? How will we respond? How will I respond?

Someone is Watching and Wondering



When was the last time you heard bell-ringing as a call for Mass to begin? Did you know we have a large bell for just that purpose? Here are photos to confirm; yes St. James has a bell in a tower, with a clapper for ringing. Where is it you might ask? In the prayer garden, I reply.

For those of you who have not heard it, let me share a bit of its history. First, let me say it isn't the bell from Old St. James on Water Street. In fact that bell is sitting on the floor, at RedX in Riverside, where it has been since a collector bought it. The current bell, in our prayer garden came from Holy Trinity Parish at 9th and Norton in Kansas City, Missouri. When that parish was closed by the Diocese, many items were auctioned. Unable to acquire the Old St. James bell (after 2 years of negotiations), the Holy Trinity bell was purchased in 1991. Funds for the purchase were raised through a talent show and a donation in memory of Mike Cambiano. This bell was cast in bronze in 1932 by the Stuckstede Co, of St. Louis, MO. One of our parishioners, Helen Lynn, brought this information to my attention recently, and it was confirmed by John Winkels who facilitated the purchase. Sadly, the bell needed restoration and re-installation before we could hear its beautiful sound, and this required additional funds. As the above pictures confirms, however, the restoration and tower building were eventually completed. Mike Jones and his team who built the current tower, spent many long hours and plenty of sweat to insure a safe location for this bell.

Although the bell has a beautiful tone it is difficult to hear from inside our worship space, unless the doors remain open to the outside. Still, calling of the faithful to worship is a long tradition in Judeo-Christian life, and remains an important aspect of public prayer. Perhaps we can reinstate that tradition at St. James, and one day re-acquire the original bell which hung at the church on Water Street. Everything worthwhile requires patience, persistence and funds. Just wanted to share this piece of our heritage.

MakerSpace is here!

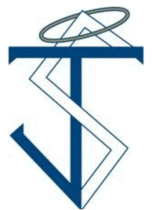


At St. James School, students are given the opportunity to explore learning in a variety of ways. This year, we have implemented a new MakerSpace. Every makerspace is unique.
