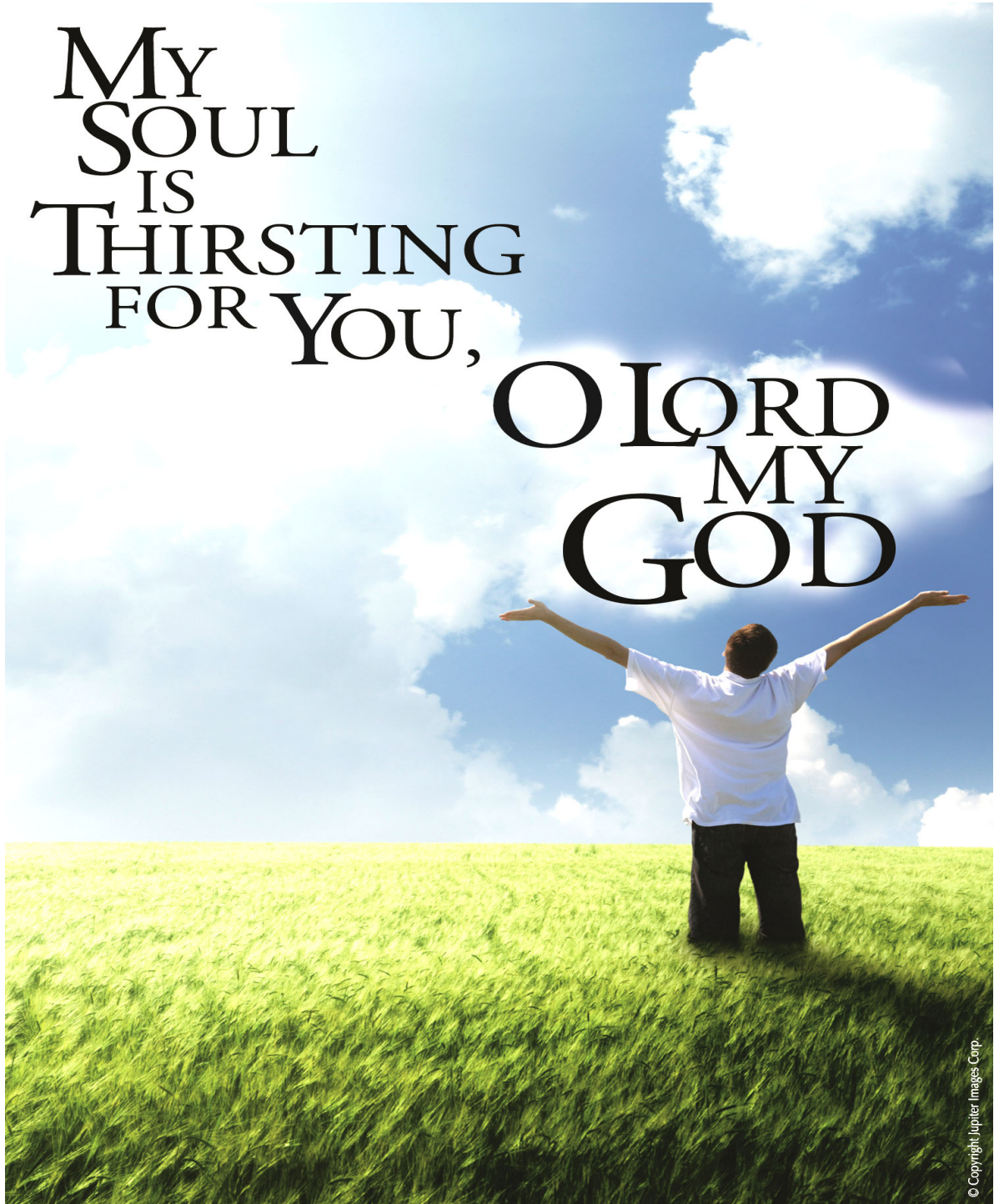

Someone is Watching and Wondering



November is traditionally designated the month to remember all who have died. While reflecting on the many deceased people who have touched my life, my mind was drawn to all those I never knew who died because of war, violence, and hatred. I continue to wonder what it would

be like if there were no wars; if people truly loved and respected one another; if we never objectified another human being. I must confess, however, that it is difficult to envision such a world. Throughout my entire life there has been one violent conflict after another, spread throughout the world. In a country that claims to be “One Nation Under God,” people continued to kill one another. Is it possible, I ask, to “Give Peace a Chance” and live in harmony. My faith says yes, through living Jesus’ teachings but my sense of reality says “Unlikely.”

The prophet Isaiah proclaims of Emmanuel “*Justice shall be the band around his waist, and faithfulness a belt upon his hips. Then the wolf shall be a guest of the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; the calf and the young lion shall browse together, with a little child to guide them. The cow and the bear shall be neighbors, together their young shall rest; the lion shall eat hay like the ox. The baby shall play by the cobra’s den, and the child lay his hand on the adder’s lair. There shall be no harm or ruin on all my holy mountain; for the earth shall be filled with knowledge of the Lord, as water covers the sea.*” (11:5-9) The picture painted by the prophet seems like utopia, an unreachable dream, a place I want to live. Year after year we hear these words proclaimed during our liturgy but little seems to change.

I have been blessed to feel the inner peace of God many times in my life and I realize His thoughts and ways are not my thought and ways. I also know the God is timeless, therefore, the time constraints by which we live are not part of God’s plan. Yet I find it easy to become frustrated by the conditions that seemingly persist in this world in which we live. I find it difficult to understand why so many people who identify as Christians continue to speak words of hate and bigotry. I don’t know why we continue to objective one another with course language or how we can ignore so many of our brothers and sisters who lack the basics of life (clean water, food, shelter, health care, education, jobs with a live able wage). Then I turn these questions back onto myself and remember His words: “Love one another even as I have loved you.” I know my answer must be, “Lord, renew my hope and let peace begin with me.”

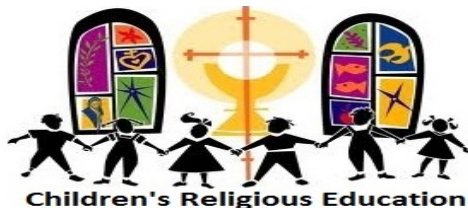
