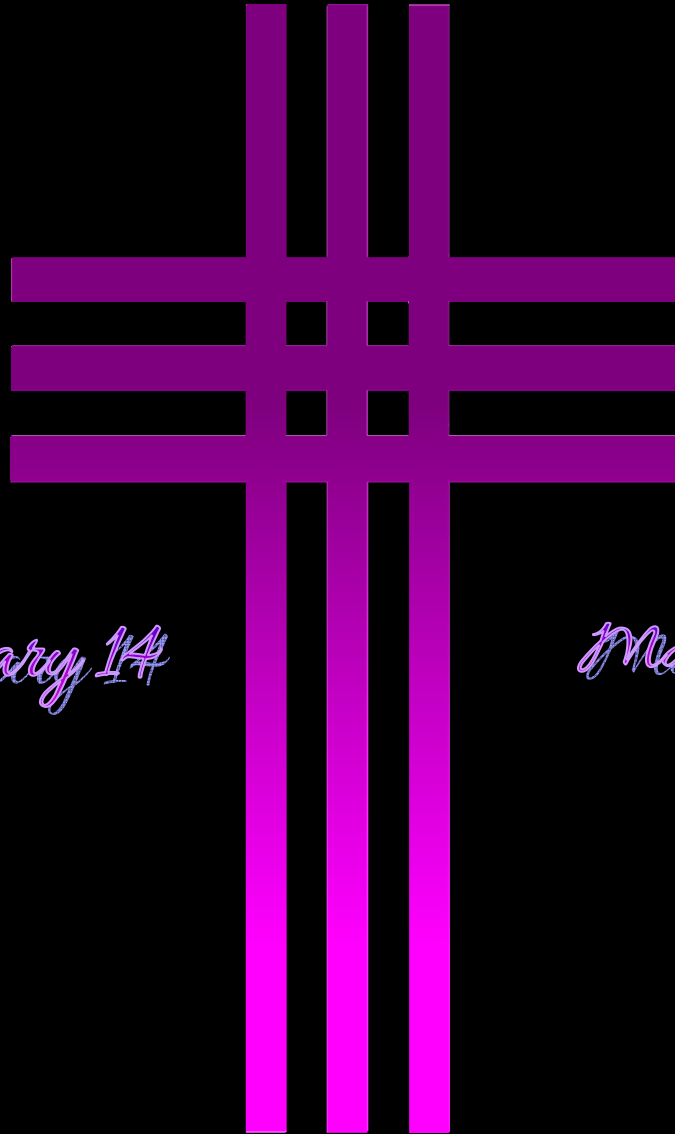

You can definitely say that enlarging the areas covered by cameras expands our overall security coverage dramatically.

In the coming weeks we will outline for you enhancements to our facility exterior lighting.

## From the Pastor's Pen

And so the story goes, Phil saw his shadow and we are to expect six more weeks of winter. From the sounds of the weather report predicting snow, we just might get some winter yet. That cold, crisp winter wind cuts right through you to remind you that you are still alive, nothing else like it.

This past weekend, I had the opportunity to travel to St. Mary's in Carrolton, MO, and celebrate Mass. Fr. Ken Criqui, Pastor, was invited to join a couple for a trip to Rome. The couple, the husband a Baptist and his wife, Catholic, invited Fr. Criqui to join them to travel and see the churches of Rome. It has been her dream to travel to Rome, but since showing signs of early Alzheimer, her husband wanted to honor her wishes while she could still enjoy the sights.

Carrolton is a small rural town in Missouri about an hour away. I was asked three years ago to give a Parish Mission. As it was our 200th anniversary of the founding of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood, I said yes and my theme for the three nights was Cup, Cross, Covenant through the lens of Precious Blood spirituality. I have been asked again to consider giving another Parish Mission. At the end of this month, I will return to Carrolton and preach another Parish Mission. It will be focused on the season of Lent with a vision still to be determined.

Driving into Carrolton, passing a couple grain silos and farm implement dealers, the farm boy in me stirred. I still enjoy getting away from the city and driving through the country. Just once, I want to stop when I see a tractor or combine rolling in the field, and ask the farmer if I might join him for a round. Just one round. I shared that dream, and got a few offers that when I return at the end of the month, I'm most welcome to go for a round. I'm not sure February is the best month for that dream. As I finished Mass at the mission church in Norborne, I was greeted by the snow. I told one family, "I just want one more snow, so I can go 4x4ing." He looked at me, "Father, I'll pray for that, and so you can take the snow with you back to Liberty!" He chuckled and walked away. With snow predicted, we will see if I get my wish!

If it be six more weeks of winter, may we prayer for good health and one more snow that lasts but a day.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Light, how amazing to behold! I have been thinking about light for some time now, especially since witnessing the total solar eclipse this past summer. It was truly amazing to observe how fast the day became totally dark then just as quickly returned to bright light. Pure light is white like the moon and stars at night, yet with our amazing eyes we have the ability to see light broken into the many colors of the visible spectrum. Like the rainbow there are shades of red, orange, yellow, blue, indigo, and violet, which combine to form infinite shades and hues. God has blessed us with the capability to behold sights like the Northern Lights, wild flowers blooming in the fields, colorful birds singing in the trees, waterfalls, corals, fish and so many other natural wonders. What a perfect gift. Yet God didn't stop here, he gave us Jesus the true light of the world. In turn, Jesus calls us to be his "light to the world." We cannot hide His light, rather we are to let it shine through our good works so that others may "give glory to God." (Matthew 5:14) Sometimes I wonder, if the Christ light is within me, why have I built such a shell around myself that keeps His light hidden? What do I hold within, kept in darkness? Am I afraid to let His light in, or am I afraid to let my darkness out?

As we enter Lent this Wednesday I think it is important to ask these questions. Instead of thinking about some trivial thing to give up for Lent, think of what hiddenness in your life needs to be brought to His light. Before making a confession we examine our consciousness and name our sinfulness in need of the healing Sacrament of Reconciliation. Why not begin this Lenten Season with the same self examination. How is it possible to be His light if we are broken ourselves? I find myself asking, "What color of light do I reflect to others?" Is Jesus' light shining through my actions bright like the stars, is it seen by others in many colors, or like the eclipsed sun do others see only my brokenness and darkness. God sees all, so why hesitate to let Him replace your darkness with light.

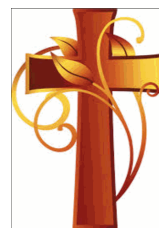

### Can I afford a Catholic Education?



#### Tithe vs. Tuition



At St. James School, parents can either fulfill a tithe yearly, or pay tuition costs directly to the school. Here is an explanation of how tithing for education at St. James works.

#### Tithing:

- Tithing is a financial contribution to the church. Generally, a tithe is considered to be 10% of income. (5% to parish, 1% to diocese, 4% to either church or other organizations of your choice)
- In order to participate in a tithing education, your family must be registered and active Catholics at St. James Parish.
- This is defined as a family who:
  - Attends Sunday Mass regularly
  - Receive the Sacraments regularly
  - Contributes financial support to the parish with fulfillment of yearly pledge (The pledge year runs from Jan. 1 - Dec. 31)

#### Tuition:

- Tuition costs can vary year to year. Parents are welcome to pay yearly, by semester, or monthly (from August - May).
- A schedule of fees can be found in the school office.
