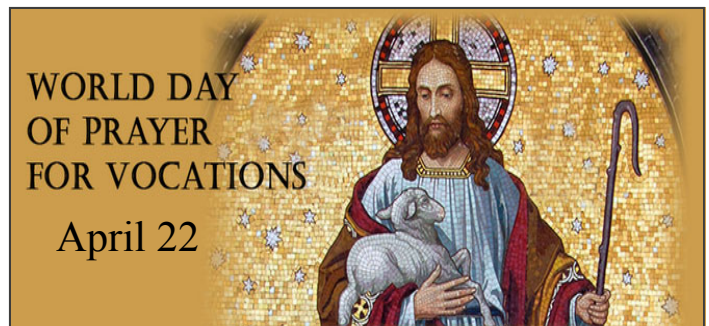

## Someone is Watching and Wondering

*Peace*  
*be with*  
 *you*

At every Mass we hear these words and just before receiving the body and blood of Christ we offer these same words to those around us.

According to the Gospel of John this simple greeting was uttered by Jesus

when he appeared to the disciples after the resurrection (John 20:19, 21). I'm sure you remember the scene. The disciples were huddled together in a locked room after the dark days of Jesus death. I am confident they were fearful, confused, and despairing but I also feel they felt guilt ridden. After all Peter denied Him and most of the others abandoned Him. We are told only the beloved disciple remained and stood at the foot of the cross with Jesus' mother, Mary. When Jesus appears in that locked room, however, he does not rebuke them for their actions. Instead he greets them with "Peace be with you." He did not rebuke them, there were no sarcastic comments or recriminations, no taunting reminders of their running away in fear. Jesus had no reason for revisiting the past. Rather he pointed His followers toward the future. With the help of the Holy Spirit, the disciples could begin again to live His teachings. All their transgressions and lack of understanding were forgiven with Jesus' loving words of peace.

I think about this fact, and the words of Sr. Mary Jo Kennedy spoken to me shortly after I became a Catholic. In speaking about receiving communion she said, "If you cannot turn to the person next to you with a forgiving and loving heart and sincerely offer the peace of Christ, you should not receive His body and blood. Reconcile first; seek and offer forgiveness before you receive." I remember her words whenever I prepare myself to receive communion. I also realize there isn't an option to simply not offer His peace to others. His way is to let go, to forgive, and to love one another. This is the path I must follow if I am to live in Christ's peace.

My husband Gene used the words "Know the peace of Christ." Although I find myself uttering Gene's words I also realize that I am also offering His peace and love that can only flow and be shared through each of us. As we continue in this beautiful season of Easter I pray that I may be an instrument of His peace. Let me sow pardon, faith, hope, light, joy, consolation, understanding and love.

Through Confirmation, the Holy Spirit gives us the increased ability to practice our Catholic faith in every aspect of our lives and to witness Christ in every situation.



The effects of Confirmation are as follows:

- An increased portion of the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, knowledge, right judgment, understanding, courage, piety, and fear of the Lord
- A deepening and strengthening of the grace received at Baptism, which is considered the presence of God in the soul
- A more intimate relationship with Jesus Christ
- A closer bond with the Catholic Church
- The ability to take a greater, more mature role in the Church's mission of living the Christian faith daily and witnessing to Christ everywhere
- A special mark, or character, on the soul that can never be erased

Each person's ability to embrace these effects depends on his or her openness to the sacrament and willingness to accept it as God's personal gift.

### 2017 - 2018 Daring Disciples Deliver Respect

#### *Behind the Scenes at the Thrift Store* Skip the Garage Sale!

Have you ever wondered about how the Hillcrest Hope Thrift store works? What do they do with all the stuff that gets donated? I asked those questions of Rachel Hollin-



berger, the program marketing director of Hillcrest Hope. She told me that when you shop at the Hillcrest store, you are "shopping with impact" because not only do the cash profits from the store support the apartments, but the families in the apartments can also get their needs met there too. Their goal is to offer quality merchandise that is very affordable. They always have in-season clothes, so that means not only regular clothes, but also fancy dresses during prom season, Halloween costumes during September and October, Christmas sweaters after Thanksgiving, etc. They re-purpose 95% of their donations, which means your donations will find another useful life after you no longer need them.



She said that sometimes, for whatever reason, items just won't sell here. For those items, rather than sending them to a landfill, they work with a local exporter to send things like linens, house-

wares, clothes, shoes, toys, belts & purses to African villages in need. Books are sent to the same places and used to teach English. All of the packaging materials, cardboard boxes etc. are recycled locally to reduce waste. It's an amazing conservation of resources. They really find a home and a use for every donation!

So as we head into garage sale season, keep in mind that you can always opt to "skip the sale" and call for a free pickup. They'll send out a truck and load your donations up. You get the tax donation, Hillcrest finds a new home for your treasures, and you can support the very good work that the Hillcrest Hope program does in our community. In my own family, when my husband's parents and aunt moved to assisted living, we had two entire households of "leftover" things they no longer needed. Hillcrest was wonderful to work with and SO much easier than hassling with a garage sale when we had so many other issues on our plate. It felt really good to know that their things were helping people in need here in Liberty.
