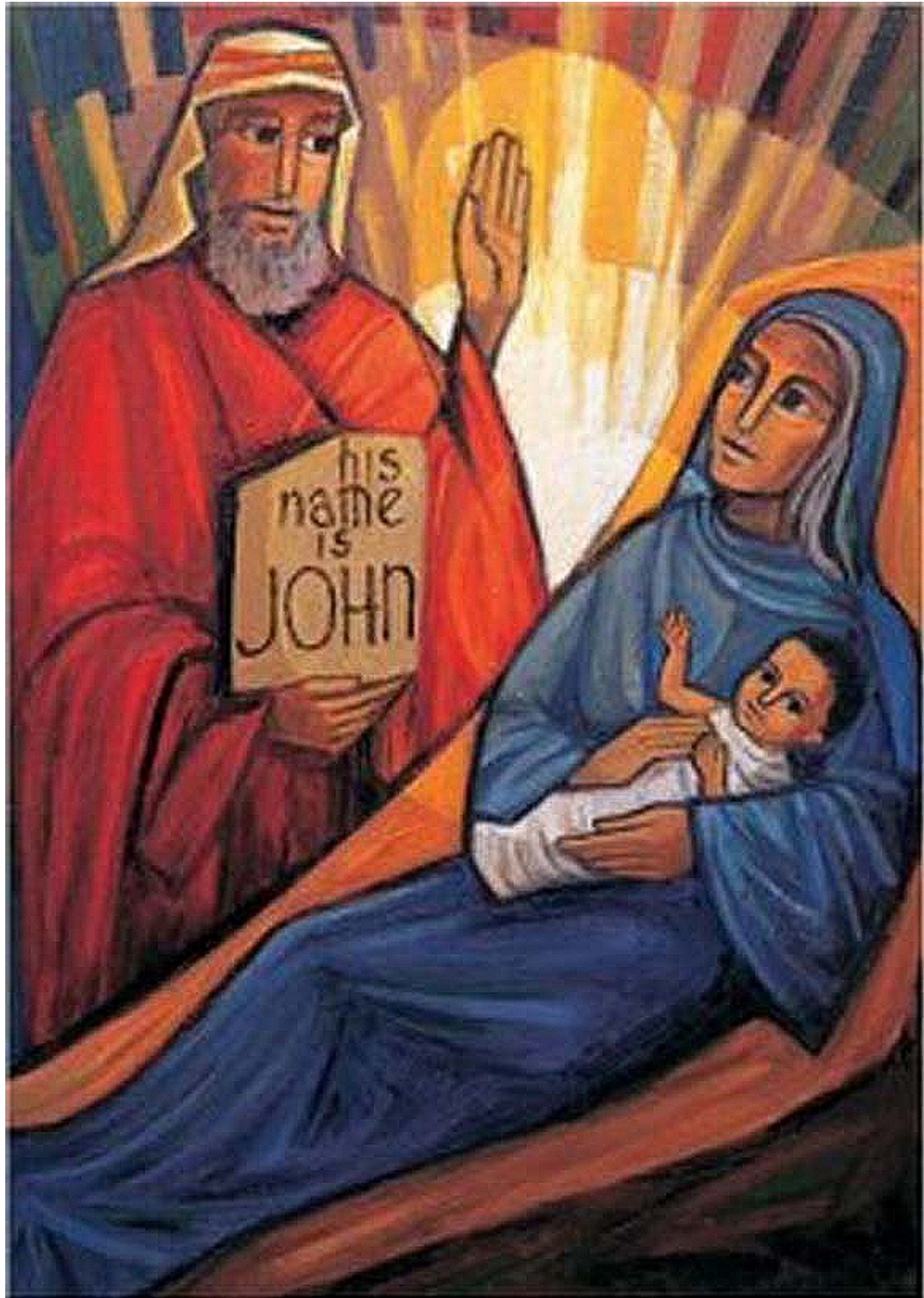

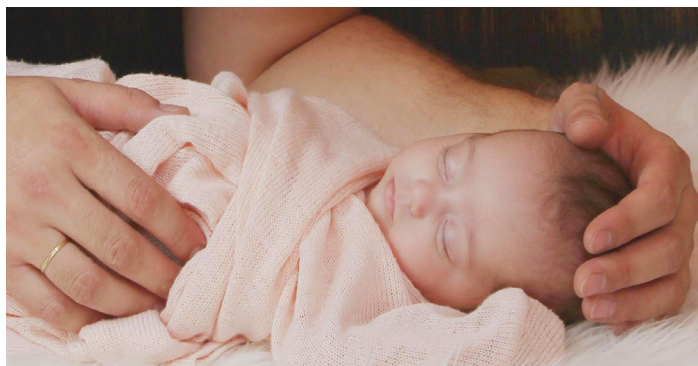

O LORD, you have probed me, you know me:

### *Reflection*

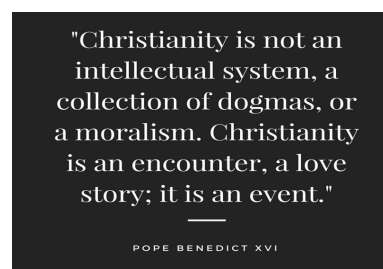
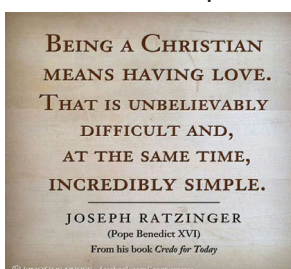
We are wonderfully, fearfully made. Our dignity is not in our utility to others or the state. It is not in our convenience or abilities. It is not that others want us or do not want us.

Our dignity is that we are willed and loved by God.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Last week I shared several individual's thoughts on what it means to be Catholic and I left you with words from Pope Francis that our lives must be grounded in God. I hope you don't mind if I continue and begin with two more quotes:



Reflecting on these words, I believe that before I can describe what it means to be a Catholic, I must first understand and articulate what it means to be a Christian. Combining the words of Pope Francis and Pope Benedict XVI, being a Christian involves falling in love with God, centering my life in Him, and trying to live by His teachings, giving of myself through acts of love and compassion. Point of fact, I believe this is the responsibility and privilege of everyone who calls themselves Christian.

If this is true for all Christians, what is different for Catholics. For me the word *HOLISTIC* describes my catholicity. We are a welcoming community of faith, who understand the sacraments as the real presence of Christ. When we gather for Mass we believe He is present in the assembly, the word proclaimed, the priest as he leads us, and in the communion we share, (His body and blood - humanity and divinity). We do not, however, leave God when we exit. Instead we carry Him into our every day, ordinary lives. We are called to witness to His presence in the world and to recognize that everyday, all of nature which surrounds us, the entire Universe, and most especially life itself is sacred, pure gift, given to us without question from our heavenly Father. As Catholics we are called to see the face of God in one another, to love, respect, and care for all He provides. Yes, being Catholic is Holistic, it fills us, centers our lives, and unites us to God and one another.

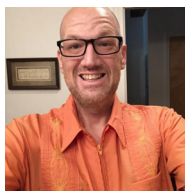

St. Paul was the Apostle of the Gentiles. His letters are included in the writings of the New Testament, and through them we learn much about his life and the faith of the early Church.

In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo said of Sts. Peter and Paul: "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood."
