What Questions Do You Have about the Campaign?

Here Are some Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

As we prepare for our fall building campaign for a new church, we want to be up front and transparent with all information. The following are several FAQs that we have heard from parishioners. We will keep you updated in each newsletter with additional FAO's about the campaign. If you have a question, please contact Father Mike, Father Timothy or Jim Newell. We'll be sure to get your questions answered.

How much money has the Current Capital Campaign raised since June 16, 2009?

\$857,000 through March 31, 2012

Were campaign expenses paid from the money raised?

Yes, \$113,493 which includes all campaign expenses and our threeyear contract with our fundraising partner, Church Development.

Were additional loans made from the Diocese in this time frame?

Yes, we borrowed \$185,000 to cover a portion of our latest educational facility. These "soft expenses" included items such as furniture, window coverings, fans, floor coverings, telephone systems, security systems, etc. which should have been included in the original loan and were paid for from operating funds. We borrowed less, but this approach left the parish cash strapped. The total amount of these "soft expenses" exceeded \$212,000.

Yes, all designated funds are separated from Parish Operating accounts, fully funded and retained in separate bank accounts.

Does St James have a contingency fund to cover cash flow fluctuations?

St James has no contingency fund. We were forced to borrow \$30,000 in March of this year to cover a shortage in our budgeted operating income.

Can you estimate St James' loan balance in June 2012.

At this moment we estimate the loan balance on June 30, 2012 at \$995,000.

What is the latest on our Long Range Planning?

MAY

- ✓ General interviews conducted with five local contractors for a Master Plan.
- ✓ Three contractors selected to be interviewed as design/build teams.

JUNE

- ✓ Design/Build team selected for Master Plan.
- ✓ Master Planning process begins and continues through mid-August.
- ✓ Opportunities for parishioner input into Master Planning process will be announced in early summer.
