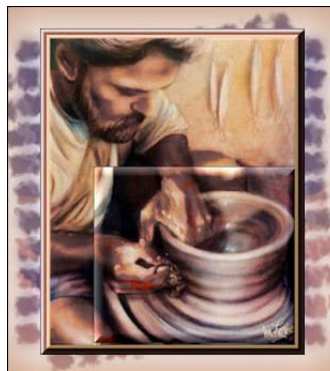

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Recently, I read these words: "by the grace of God, I am what I am," (1 Cor 15:10). Reflecting on this passage I was reminded of this verse from Isaiah 64:8, "we are the clay and you the potter: we are the work of your hands." We've all heard these words, but

have we accepted who we are?

When was the last time you berated yourself, put yourself down, or rejected a compliment? I'm not talking about having regrets for a sinful action. What I'm talking about is rejecting who you are; rejecting what God has created, the unique you. Yes, that includes everything, your looks, intelligence, relationships, work, shortcomings, situations in life; you are simply who/what your are, God's creation. Further, if you accept that you are made in image and likeness of God, if you accept the incarnation, then how can you reject yourself?

Looking through some old files I found this poem by David Sutcliff, which I want to share with you:

"Like clay pried from the yielding earth, shapeless and raw, yet full of promise, I was born and took the first fragile breath, egged on by midwife's clout to draw lungfuls of air, polluted but life-giving.

Washed by the regenerating stream of soft baptismal water, into a new birth and new world.

Molded by pressures of training and experience and the sure touch of nail-printed hands, into evolving shape.

Plunged into the white-hot searing flame of testing and proving, the kiln of divine love. Burnished to begin the work of wearing down the bumps and ridges of pride, intolerance, selfishness and fear.

I come to you. Shape me. Mold me. I am but clay in your hand.

And when I seem broken on the turning wheel of life, battered by the self-inflicted damage of my sin, dented by accident or hurt and feel to be again a mass of unworked clay or broken shard, then help me to believe that I can be re-formed, re-worked, and given new meaning.

I come to you. Reshape me. Remold me. Divine potter, I am as clay in your hand."

Join me today as I pray: Lord, I know I am what I am, your creation, so remold me when I sin, and help me believe.

to celebrate the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary

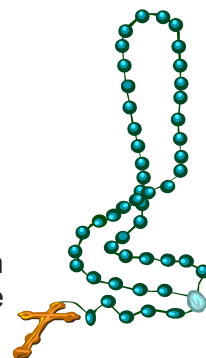
PLACE: Our Church

In our diocese, in order to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion, a child must meet the following criteria:

- *Must be at least 7 years old
- *Must be in at least the 2nd grade
- *Must have had a least one year prior religious instruction and formation, whether in a Catholic school or a parish school of religion or in a qualified program of home study.

If your child meets these guidelines, and you did not attend either parent meeting in September, please contact Cecilia Richardson in the parish office to schedule a one-on-one make up as soon as possible.

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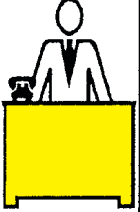
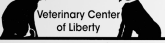
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
