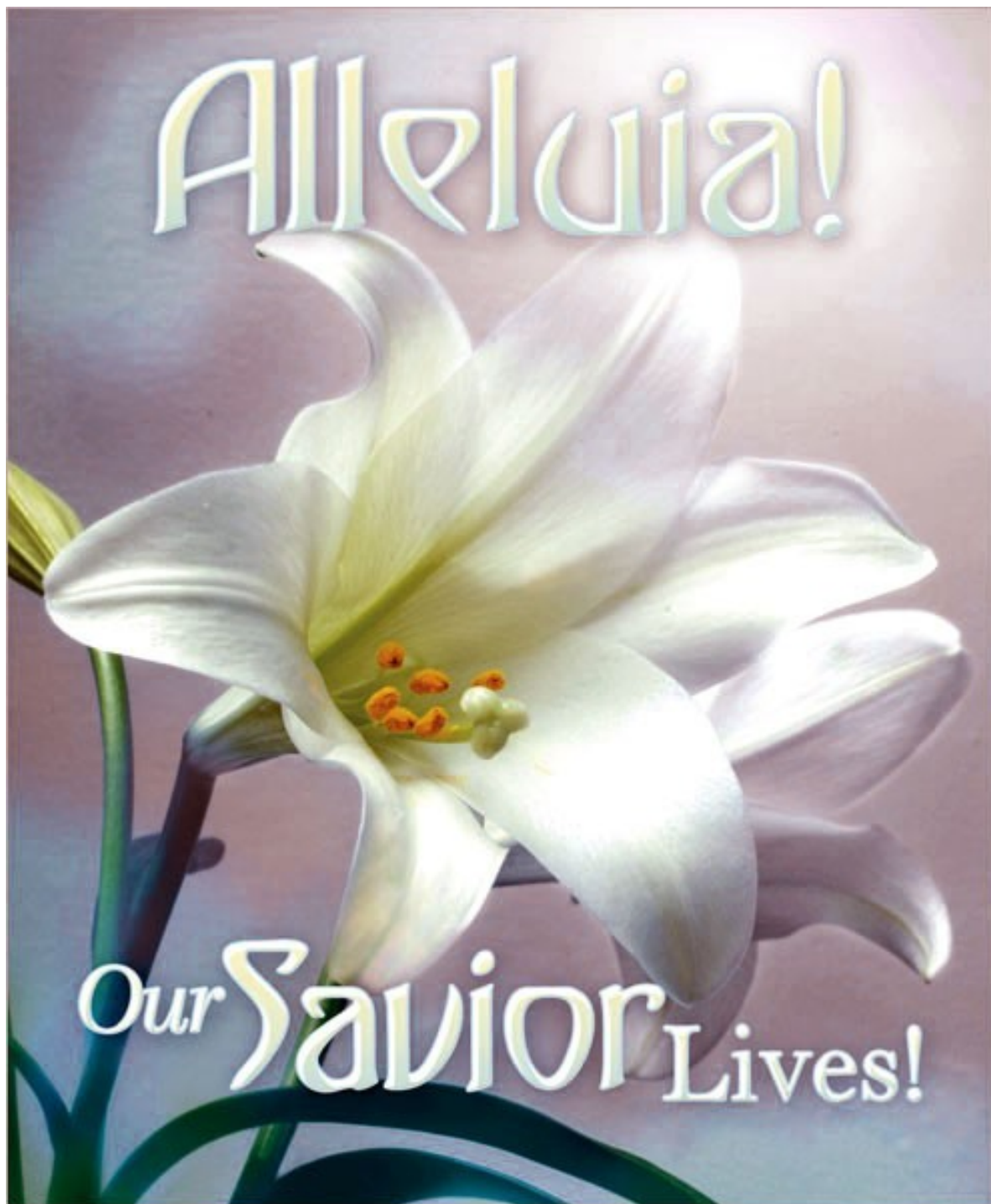

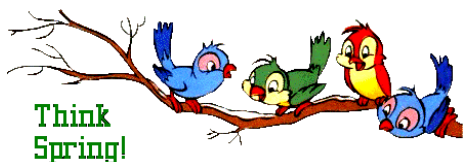

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Lent has passed, we celebrated the *Triduum*, we welcomed new members to our faith community, and today we gather to **Rejoice in**

St Irenaeus said, "The glory of God is a human being fully alive, and Teilhard de Chardin said "We are not human beings trying to become spiritual; we are spiritual beings. . .trying and needing to become human for one another." Lord, let me rejoice in the newness of my life, and help me embrace my humanity to its fullness. **Happy Easter!**

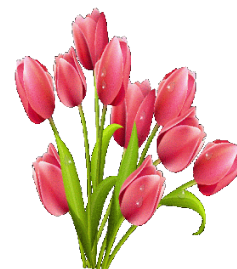
