Someone is Watching and Wondering

J Generally it is this time of year that I receive inquiries regarding the process of Christian Initiation (becoming Catholic), so I thought it appropriate to summarize the distinct stages of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, which the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy (*Sacrosanctum Concilium*) re-established.

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1a. Period of evangelization and precatechumenate: This is a time, of no specific duration or structure, for inquiry and introduction to Gospel values. It provides an opportunity for the beginnings of faith formation.

1b. Acceptance into the Order of Catechumens. This is the liturgical rite which marks the beginning of the catechumenate proper, when the candidates express and the Church accepts their intention to respond to God's call to follow Christ.

2a. Period of the catechumenate: This time is for nurturing and growth of the catechumens' faith and conversion to God, with a duration corresponding to the progress of the individual, not to the school, liturgical, or calendar year. During this period catechumens are gradually catechized through essentially an ecclesial act. The church, (those baptized and catechized) continuing the mission of Jesus as teachers, actively transmit the faith, establishing in the hearts of the catechumens a profound experience of life. The faithful provide an example of openness to the Holy Spirit, and join the catechumens on their journey by reflecting on the paschal mystery, and growing spiritually. The focus of catechesis is Jesus, and its goal is to lead people to communion and intimacy with Him. The six fundamental tasks of catechesis are: **promoting knowledge of the faith, liturgical education, moral formation, prayer, education for community life, and missionary invitation.**

2b. Election or Enrollment of Names. This is the liturgical rite, celebrated on the First Sunday of Lent, when the Church formally ratifies the catechumens' readiness for the sacraments of initiation, and the newly **Elect**, express their desire to receive the sacraments.

3a. Period of Purification and Enlightenment: This time immediately precedes the elects' initiation, usually corresponding to Lent. It is a time of reflection, intensely centered on conversion, marked by celebration of the scrutinies and preparation for the rites on Holy Saturday.

3b. Celebration of the Sacraments of Initiation. During this liturgical rite, usually integrated into the Easter Vigil, the elect receive the initiation sacraments, Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

4. Period of Postbaptismal Catechesis or Mystagogy: During the Easter season, neophytes experience the fullness of community through pertinent catechesis, and participation in the Sunday Eucharistic celebration.

St. James Feast Day – July 25

Saturday, July 25 is the Feast Day St. James the Greater, the patron saint of our church.

The son of Zebedee and Salome, "our" St. James is called "the Greater" to distinguish him from the Apostle James "the Less", who was probably shorter of stature. He was the brother of John, the beloved disciple. Zebedee, his father, was a fisherman of the Sea of Galilee. Salome, his mother, was one of the pious women who afterwards followed Christ and "ministered unto him of their substance."

James is described as one of the first disciples to join Jesus. When he first encountered Jesus, there probably was no indication that this was the day that his life would change. The dawn for him was not the bright beginning of a new day, but the end of long fruitless night of fishing. As James sat mending his nets in the boat with his brother John and his father Zebedee, he must have watched in wonder as his partner Simon brought in nets loaded with fish he had caught at the command of Jesus.

As Jesus walked towards James, followed by Simon and Andrew, He didn't pass him by. He stopped by their boat and called James and his brother John to do just what Simon and Andrew had done – follow Him. Without argument or discussion, James and John left their boat and even their father behind, and followed Jesus.

James was one of only three apostles whom Jesus selected to bear witness to his Transfiguration.

The Acts of the Apostles records that "herod the king" (traditionally identified with Herod Agrippa) had James executed by sword. He is the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament.

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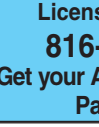
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
