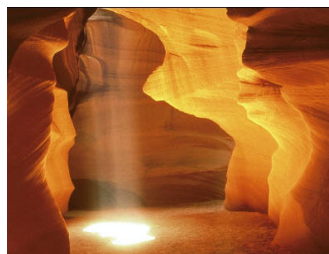

## ***Someone is Watching and Wondering***



I have always thought mystics were people whose lives were totally occupied with quiet meditation, prayer, and reflection. To me they were individuals full of deep thoughts, yet removed from the world. I also found many of their writings overwhelming difficult, confusing and hard to understand. Recently, however, I found this

quote by Evelyn Underhill: "For (mystics,) contemplation and action are not opposites, but two interdependent forms of a life that is one — a life that rushes out to a passionate communion with the true and beautiful." She spoke to my heart, and I have begun to take another look at the writings and actions of some of the mystics. I have been surprised. Perhaps it is where I am in my own life, but some of their words are beginning to take root in my mind and heart as I search for deeper meaning and peace, and there changed lives have encouraged me to keep moving toward a life in Christ.

Mysticism involves "the explicit experience, of the immediate presence of God . . . with(in) a framework of meaning" (Encyclopedia of Catholicism, Harper Collins, 1995). In-other-words these experiences are open to interpretation based on individuals culture, life-style, past experiences, traditions, temperament, and ideas about God, the world and self. As I thought about this rather simple definition I realized that the patriarchs and prophets of the Hebrew scriptures could easily be called mystics, and most assuredly Jesus' disciples, and certainly Paul. "Suddenly, while he was traveling to Damascus and just before he reached the city, there came a light from heaven all around him. He fell to the ground and then he heard a voice saying, 'Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?'" (Acts 9:3-4) Paul's response was an immediate question: "Who are you, Lord (Sir)?" Paul wasn't alone. Ananias, a disciple living in Damascus also had a vision where the Lord told him to find Saul and touch him, thus restoring his sight. We all know these encounters were the beginning of Saul's conversion to following Christ Jesus, and taking the name Paul. Subsequently Paul became a prolific missionary, spreading the Gospel around the eastern Mediterranean. Note that Saul's experience of God resulted in a change of life, a new way of living. It seems, therefore, that mysticism is not a one time experience, a static existence, but rather an experience which leads to greater activity, a call to open our hearts to Jesus, a living out of love and service to others and caring for God's creation. Isn't that the heart of the gospel message? Isn't that our call as baptized Christian, "to enter into the divine mystery through exposure and response to the Scriptures, liturgy and sacraments?"

As I have mentioned many times before, I find great solace when I am immersed in the natural world. Whether I'm taking a walk, paddling a canoe, watching birds, high in the mountains, or working in my gardens, I feel a closeness to God that seems to evade me at other times. Peace and joy seem to abound, and I can truly life my heart to God in thanksgiving. I feel energized and ready to face the next moment and the next, and the next. In a way, I suppose this is a time when I feel a mystical union with the Lord. I also feel God speaking to me through music, literature, art, and drama, leading me to greater understanding of some of my life experiences. Sometimes as I work, I know God is guiding my mind, directing my hands, and pushing me toward a goal that I have yet to realize. Still one of my greatest experiences is seeing God in others. It may be a few words, a smile, a gentle touch, help when I feel overwhelmed, or sharing tears. I don't think of myself as a mystic, yet I know that my experiences of God have changed my life, and continue to form me as one of His children. Life changes each of us. The question is do we recognize God in our lives and allow Him to form us with His love?

You can always tell when it's time for school to begin again, because things start getting very busy. It's like we all took a breather over the summer to focus on other things – Masses were

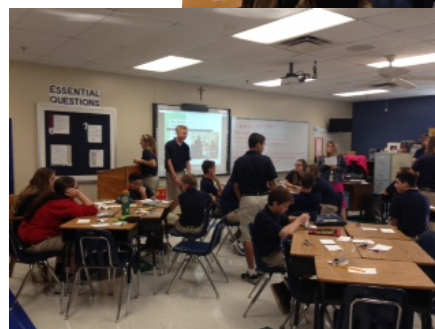
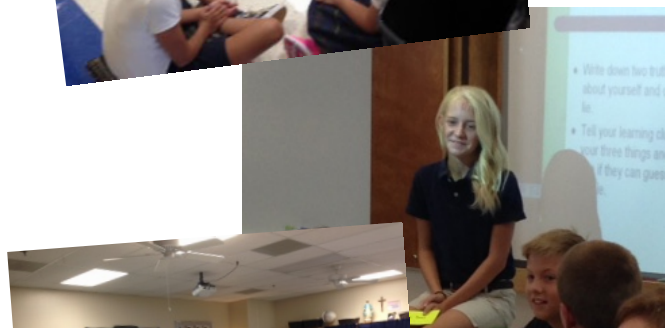
smaller, activities were simpler. Things around here were quiet.

Classes will begin on September 13th for the Sunday session, and September 16th for the Wednesday night session. The year will begin with a Family Day, so plan to come and stay with your students.



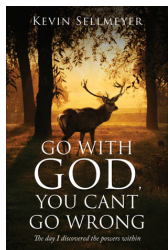

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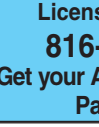
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
