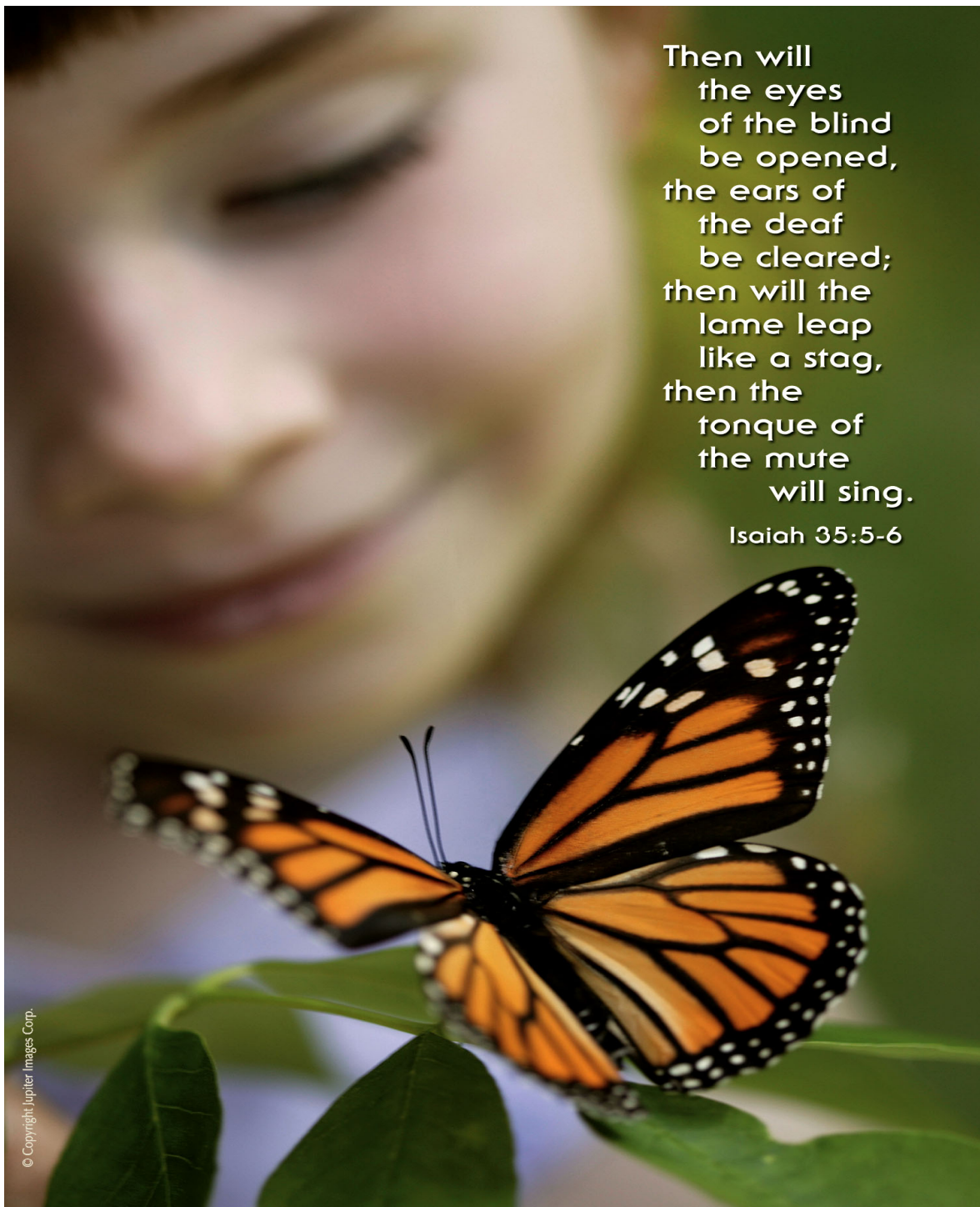

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Do you sometimes feel lost and alone? Have you experienced, or are you facing a life changing event? Is your life in the middle of a great storm, and you have no idea where to find refuge? Are you feeling

brokenness? Perhaps you are frightened, disoriented, have trouble problem solving, feel lost, angry, numb, guilty, sad or alone. Are there moments when you are just too tired to care? Are you looking for a safe environment where you can freely express your fears and concerns? If you answered yes to any of these questions, have experienced a devastating events in your life such as the death of a loved one or close friend, divorce, separation, job loss, prolonged illness, loss of a pregnancy, or a reduction in income you may consider participating in the **St. James Caring Ministry**. A commitment to this ministry involves 6 weeks, of either afternoon or evening sessions, which last approximately ninety minutes. **New sessions will begin Tuesday, September 15th at 6:30 PM or Wednesday, September 16th at 1:30 PM. We meet in the St. Gaspar room, located on the second floor of the parish office.**



As we come together in the name of Christ Jesus to share our losses, we acknowledge that healing comes through our Lord, and that we are on a journey. With Jesus as our anchor, it is our belief that the journey will lead to a new understanding of our pain which in turn helps us to refocus our lives toward Hope, Peace, Joy and Love. As we walk together, share feelings, name the pain, and shed tears, we also embrace the cross with Jesus, who gave everything so that we might live. We seek wholeness, walking in His light. We search for new direction and meaning. During each session there will be time for prayer, scripture, sharing and reflection. Although we know that God is the true healer, we also believe that He works through each of



us as we share His love with one another. This Ministry of Care will provide that safe place and time for anyone who is hurting. All sharing will be respectfully received and held in confidentiality. This is not an attempt to provide professional counseling, rather the time is intended to provide an environment for sharing personal stories with others who are also experiencing pain. There will be time for

quiet meditation, and listening to God's soft whisper and touch. We will be each others guides, fellow travelers who are searching for answers, new direction, and a continual rebirth in Christ's love. We are all broken in some way. We all need Christ. We all need the hope, peace, joy and love that only a relationship with Him can provide. We also all need human touch, compassion, and care.

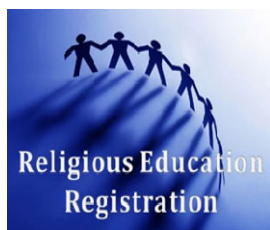

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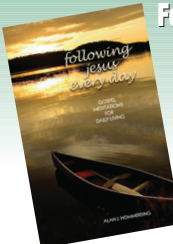
