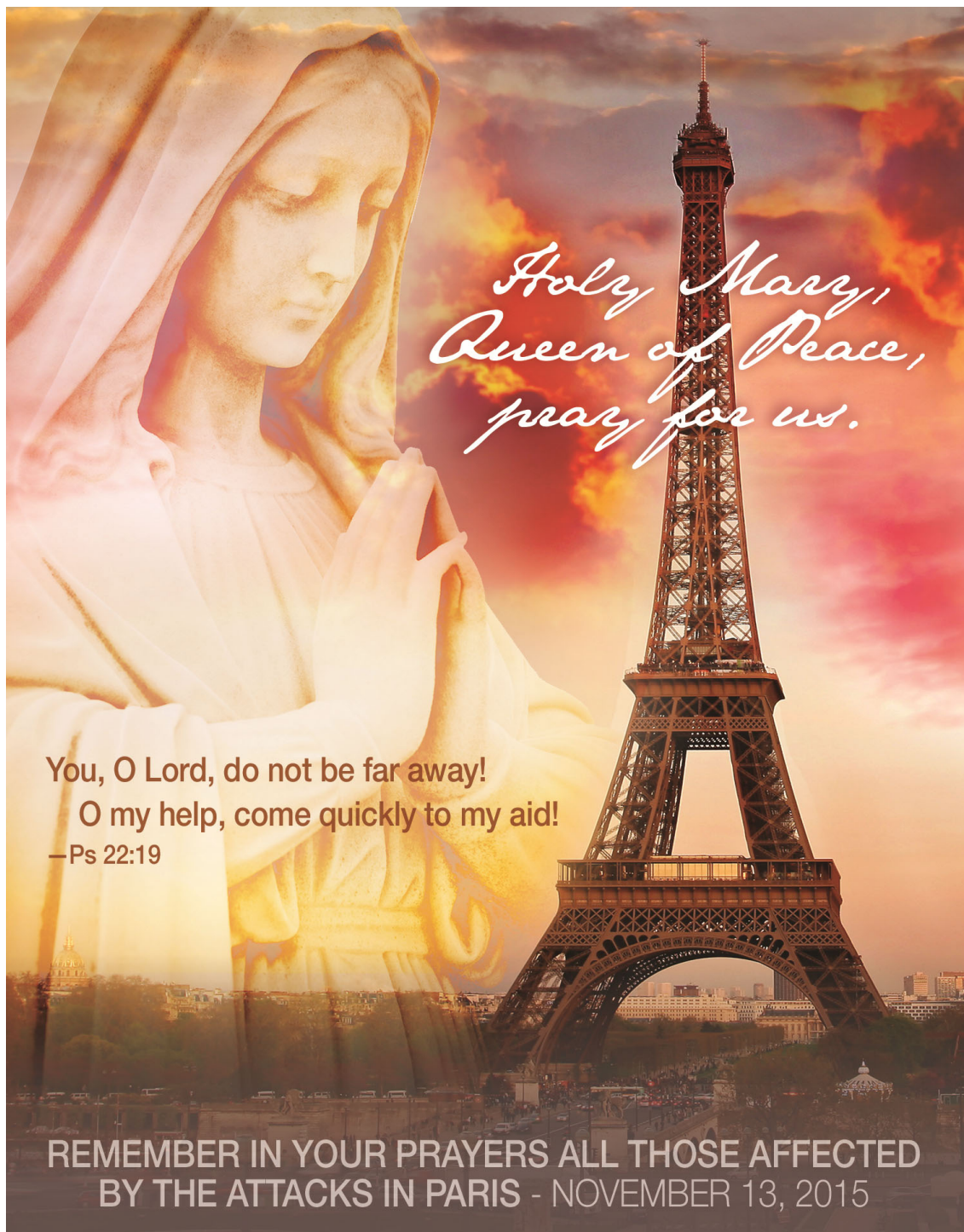

Update: Site Work on or Adjoining St. James

1. Our Landscaping Team has completed the selection process on trees that are diseased or dying. If they cannot be moved or protected, they will be removed.
2. Red Legacy Developers are committed to preparing a landscaping design between St. James and Liberty Commons which will incorporate moving or protecting selected trees. We will participate in the selection process.
3. The proposal to keep Stewart Road open to St. James during the project site work has been tabled for the present. We will continue to work with Red Legacy to minimize the period of time the road is closed. March is the probable time frame, subject to the impact of winter weather and recognition that the City will have the final say.

We will keep you apprised of activity.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Today we greet the New Liturgical Year, and once again begin the Advent Journey. I am confident most of you are familiar with the readings from the Hebrew scriptures and the Gospel, but for the next four Sundays I want to concentrate on the Epistle readings. Although these readings often seem not to fit with the other two, during this Advent they are all focus on how we prepare ourselves to receive Christ each and every day.

Today the second reading comes from I Thessalonians 3:12-4:2. "Brothers and sisters: ***May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all. . .so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones. Amen. . .conduct yourselves to please God.***" As I reflected on these words I was forced to look at my life, my physical surroundings, my attitudes and my behavior. Once again I asked myself "What do I need to change to welcome Jesus as my home guest?" Do I need to sort and dispose of inappropriate reading material, music, and DVDs? Do I need to remove clutter, and simplify the living space by putting away or getting rid of excess possessions? Are the linens clean? What will I offer Jesus at mealtime? So many questions and details to prepare and get ready for His visit.

While these may seem important to the Martha side of my personality, I do not believe they are significant, because they are secondary to what is in my mind and heart. I think the real question I should be asking, the Mary question if you will is "Have I opened my life to Jesus?" The Martha chores are quite easy, although I often fret over outward appearances. The Mary question, what is inside, is not quite so easy, because I want to be in control. I want to make decisions and plan my future for what seems pleasing and fulfilling at the moment. I often succumb to expectations from others., because I want to fit in. I don't want to appear odd, different. I don't want to stand alone. Yet, I know that loving God, giving Him my heart and mind isn't easy. For me there is fear in letting go. Trusting and depending on others, even God seems to be losing what is innately me. Giving control of my life to God, is giving away my freedom. Sometimes when I speak to others about what it means to follow Christ, not only do I feel they think I am out of touch with the 21st century, but I also feel like a hypocrite. I know my words have not always been supported by my actions. There have been times when I felt God was leading me toward a particular path, and I knowingly chose the opposite. How can I be blameless in holiness if I close my life to Christ's presence?

Although I certainly do not have a perfect answer, I am reminded of a passage from Philippians: "I can do all things through [Christ] who strengthens me." (4:13) As I prepare to receive Christ and follow His teachings, I know I am not alone. He loves me and guides me each an every day. It really doesn't matter if the day is bright and sunny, filled with happiness and good things, or whether it is darker with sadness, tension, and difficult decisions. God never abandons me. Jesus brought light into this world, and has given me His spirit to hold me close and guide me. Don't be afraid of His gentle, guiding touch. Your sister in Christ *Sandy Gagnon*

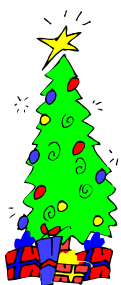
