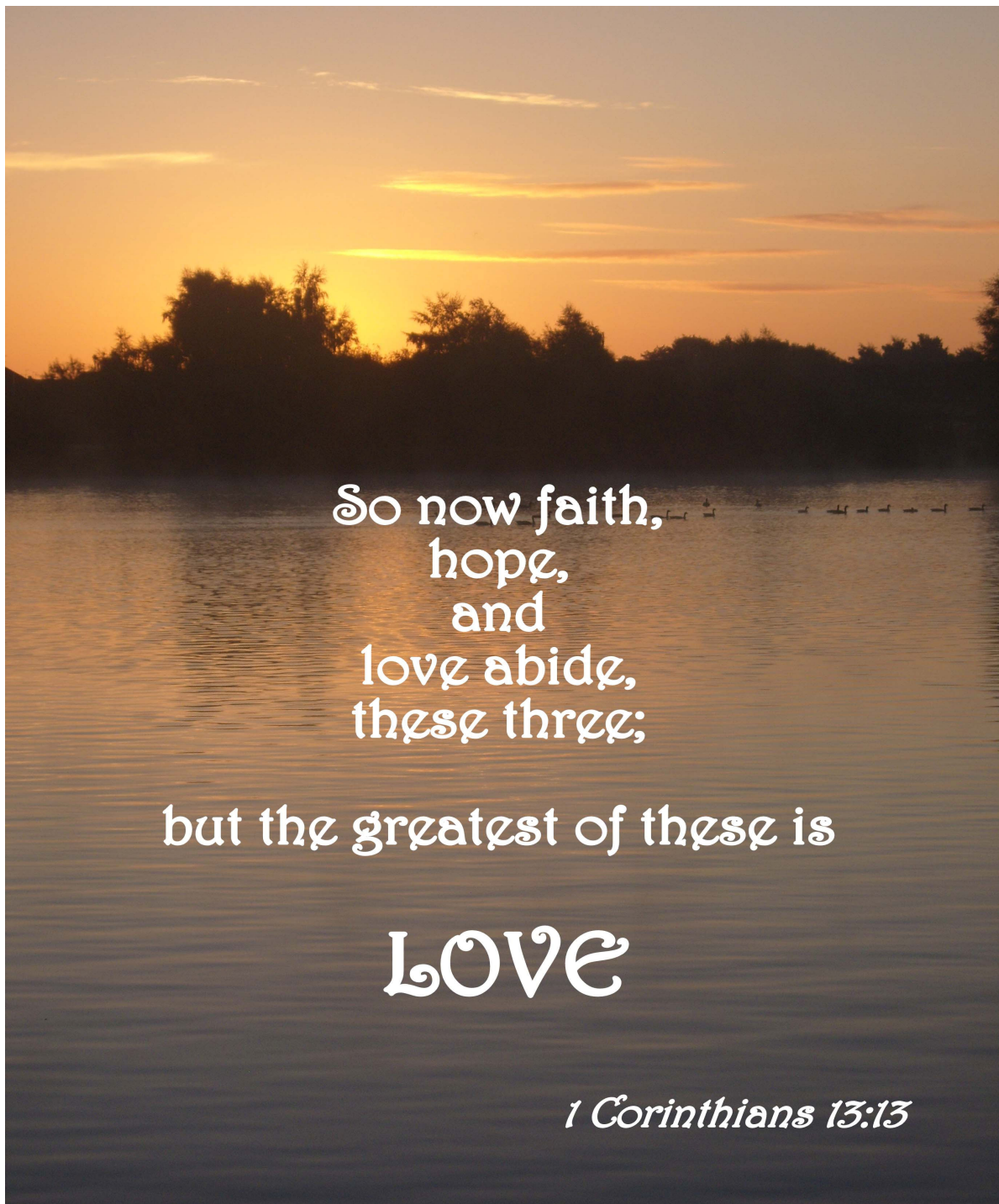

If you've always wanted to be part of this awesome choir, this is a great opportunity to join.

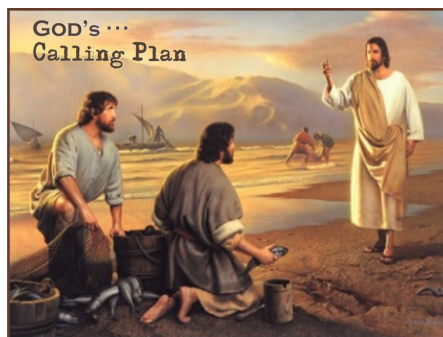

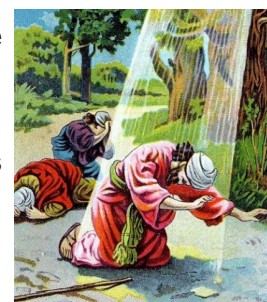

Someone is Watching and Wondering

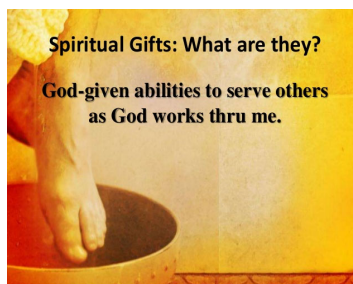


Sometimes I desire to hear Jesus' words as clearly as His call to the disciples, or have an "Ah-ha" moment as obvious as Saul's. There are times when I think I get it, and have a sense

what God wants me to do, but more often than not I feel I am simply getting through each day, doing what needs to be done. I must confess, this isn't necessarily a satisfying place to be. It seems there is more I should be doing on my journey as a Christian, instead of simply stumbling along.



When I read today's words from Jeremiah: "Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you" I strongly felt that God has a plan,



yet I continue to wonder when or how He will reveal it to me. Am I asking too much, or am I still blind to what He puts before me. Then I found this image, and I was awakened to a simple truth. His plan changes, or at least evolves as I grow in faith.

God has given me abilities and opportunities to serve. Sometimes I am called to listen, other times to teach and explain my beliefs. Sometimes I prepare a simple meal to share with others. Sometimes I offer my treasure, time or talents, and every few months, blest with excellent health, I can share my blood, given to someone I will never meet, but whose life is dependent on receiving this life giving substance. You may think I'm reaching here, but as my thoughts continued to develop, I realized that Jesus does speak to me very clearly every time I receive one of His sacraments, especially His body and blood. It is in that prayer-filled moment that I am truly in communion with my Lord. I feel nourished and spiritually rejuvenated to keep going forward each and every day. He takes me in hand, and leads me to encounter after encounter with God's other children, and I hear Jesus' words saying "tend my sheep." Perhaps not as obvious as the disciples and Saul, but non-the-less a true call from God.

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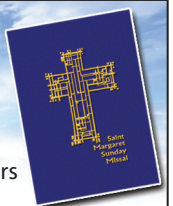
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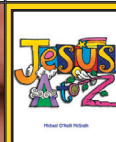
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
