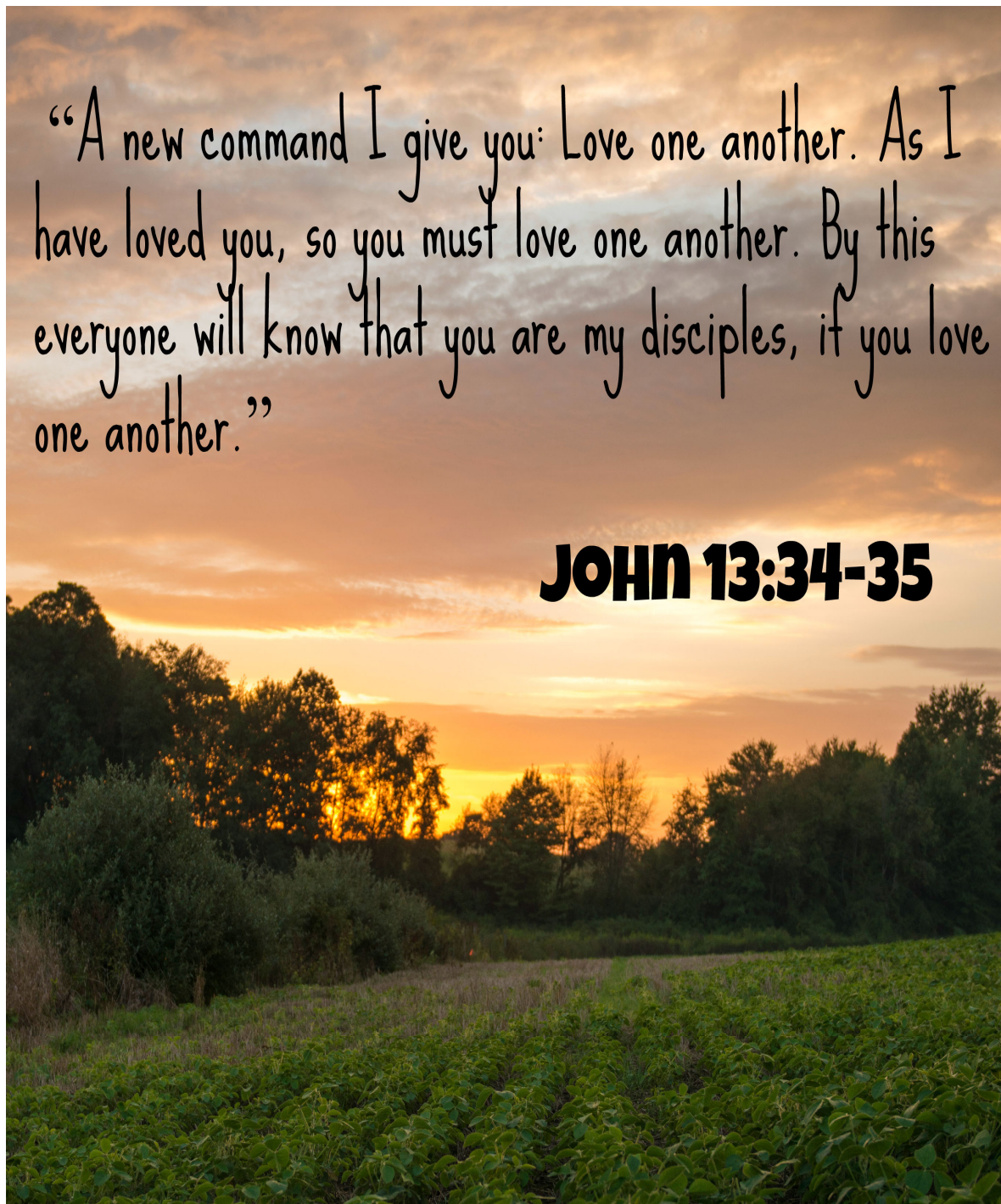

## From the Pastor's Pen

As many of us know, Pope Francis has declared this year as an Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy. As this year continues to unfold, we continually are called to enter into and experience God's mercy in our lives. We in turn are called to show that mercy to others.

Last Saturday, the ladies of the parish were invited to attend the Altar Society Retreat. Our retreat focused on the Year of Mercy and what it is all about. As I shared the information, questions came about in regards to what does one do and what is the importance of the Holy Door. As I shared information that day, I came to realize that others may or may not know or fully understand what this Jubilee Year of Mercy is all about.

The practice of a jubilee year has ancient roots in the Jewish tradition and evidence for it can be found in the Old Testament (for example, see *Leviticus 25*). The jubilee year was called every fifty years and was a time for forgiveness. It stood as a reminder of God's providence and mercy. The dedication of a year for this emphasis provided the community with a time to come back into right relationship with one another and with God. As the practice of the jubilee year was adopted into the Catholic Church, these themes of mercy, forgiveness, and solidarity continued. *Taken from USCCB.org*

Traditionally, the Jubilee Years are celebrated with the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's in Rome and everyone is invited to make a pilgrimage to Rome. Since the Jubilee Year of 1500, Holy Doors have been opened at all four of the Major Basilicas in Rome. Pope Francis broke with tradition and expanded it to include the cathedrals though out the world. "We have opened the Holy Door, here and in all the cathedrals of the world," Pope Francis said, after pushing open the massive bronze doors and pausing to pray silently on their threshold. He called the symbolic gesture "an invitation to joy".

Seven sites in our diocese have been designated as Places of Pilgrimage for the special Jubilee Year, all at which you can gain a plenary indulgence during this Jubilee Year (see page 7).

There still remains one question, what do I do? Do I just walk through the door or ? For more information please see Page 7.

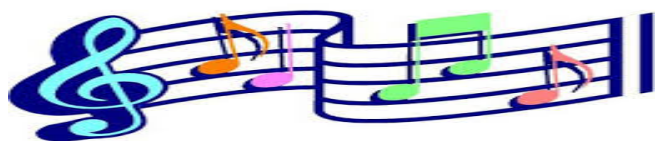

### Someone is Watching and Wondering



Would you believe this image is a jigsaw puzzle I found at [puzzlewarehouse.com](http://puzzlewarehouse.com). To me it represents a modern version of St. Paul's metaphor for the Church as the *Body of Christ*. During St. Paul's lifetime the church was not an institution or structural grouping of beliefs, creeds, and practices. Instead it was a *living organism* that communicated Jesus' message through relationships. St. Paul writes: "For as in one body we have many parts, and all the parts do not have the same function, so we though many, are one body in Christ and individually parts of one another. Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us exercise them." (Romans 12:4-6) The heart of this body, providing the energy that enlivens the community is "the love of God that has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit." (Romans 5:5) Barbara Brown Taylor in *The Luminous Web: Essays on Science and Religion* writes: "I want to proclaim that God is the unity – the very intelligence, the very elegance and passion that make it all go."

In the first chapter of Genesis we read that humankind is made in the image and likeness of God. Being made in the image of God, we of all the creatures certainly resemble God incarnate (Jesus) in physical appearance, but being made in God's likeness is something different. To me this means we must "get inside" if you will, His nature. We must follow His example and live in and through His love. We must function together, using the gifts He has given, for the common good of all humanity. We must show mercy, compassion, and kindness. We must forgive, and move toward peace and unity. **We are all Called to Protect God's, Creation**, and with April designated as **Child Abuse Prevention Month**, it seems only appropriate to rededicate our lives to His service, in full unity as the *Body of Christ*.

## Obtaining an Indulgence Through One of the Diocesan Holy Doors

Perhaps the most high-profile plenary indulgence this year is attached to the Holy Door. A Holy Door is a door in a basilica or cathedral that is only opened in a Jubilee year. Pilgrims who pass through it gain a plenary indulgence, as long as the normal requirements are met.

The door also has theological significance. Jesus called himself the gate to salvation, and it symbolizes conversion, leaving one place and entering another. Traditionally, to obtain the indulgence, one had to travel to Rome or a handful of other basilicas around the world to pass through a Holy Door. But in the *Papal Bulla* announcing the Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis granted each bishop the ability to designate Holy Doors in his diocese.

In our diocese, seven sites have been designated as Places of Pilgrimage for this special Jubilee Year that ends November 20. These sites include the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception; the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph; the Minor Basilica of the Immaculate Conception at Conception Abbey; Our Lady of Good Counsel, Kansas City; Sacred Heart/Guadalupe Parish, Kansas City; Sacred Heart Parish, Warrensburg; and Holy Rosary Parish, Clinton.

To receive the Jubilee Year Indulgence, one must fulfill the usual conditions:

- Be in a state of grace
- Have no attachment to venial sin
- Receive the Eucharist within 20 days before or after passing through the Holy Doors
- Confess one's sins within 20 days before or after passing through the Holy Doors
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope

A plenary indulgence can be gained once per day.

You may receive the plenary indulgence yourself, or offer it for a person in purgatory, but it cannot be applied to other living persons.

### A Plenary Indulgence is ...

"...a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints".

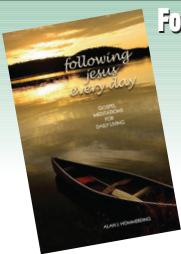


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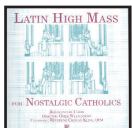


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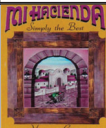


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
