Someone is Watching and Wondering



At Confirmation the Bishop announces: "Receive the gift of the Holy Spirit," and I have often wondered, is reception of the Holy Spirit obvious? Is there some chemical, physical, mental or emotional change that occurs? I think, perhaps, St. Paul's words, "No one can say, 'Jesus is Lord,' except by the Holy Spirit" provide a clue to my questions. We cannot know, without first receiving His spirit, but then I ask another? What is required to be a Christian?

As a child I went to Sunday School and Church, and what I most remember is hearing Bible stories and singing. Just before I entered Junior High School, I made a profession of faith clearly stating that I believed Jesus was my Lord and Savior, was baptized and received communion for the first time. Some would say it was through these events that I received the Holy Spirit and became a Christian. In all honesty, however, I cannot say that I felt much different or that my life changed. In some ways I was just following what seemed to be a natural progression of growing up. I couldn't see how the Spirit lived in me.

Today I can state that my conversion began when I realized I couldn't get by all on my own. I needed Jesus in my life, not just some stories about Jesus, I needed to acknowledge His presence. I needed to surrender my will to Him. I needed to embrace His love, and yes, open my mind, heart, and soul to His Spirit. In welcoming His Spirit I could finally open doors that had been tightly sealed for fear of being hurt, do things I found frightening, and learn to love unconditionally. I came to know St. Paul's words are true. It is only through the Spirit that I can honestly proclaim who Jesus is, and what it means to be His disciple. I also know that each of us is given different spiritual gifts, but together, acting as members of the Body of Christ, we can do His will. Baptized and confirmed in His name, strengthen with His body and blood, all things are possible. I think that's what it means to receive the Holy Spirit.
