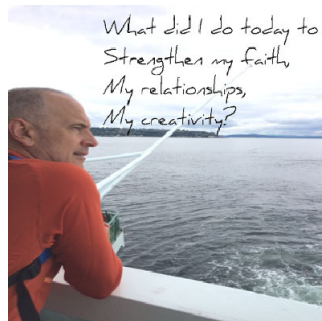

Previously I wrote about my experience of hearing Dr. C. Vanessa White speak at the National Association of Pastoral Musicians convention in Houston, TX. This week I thought I would share some more reflections with you from my time at the convention.

The goal of every Director of Liturgy and Music can be summed up in one phrase: FULL, ACTIVE AND CONSCIOUS PARTICIPATION. The document, **Sing to the Lord**, states that; *“The full and active participation by all people is the aim to be considered before all else, for it is the primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian spirit.”*

So what IS participation? It must be both internal and external. When we listen to sacred scriptures, prayers or singing by the choir, we are invited to listen and be fully engaged so that we might raise our minds to God. Externally we participate by our gestures, actions, acclamations, responses and SINGING!!! It doesn't matter what your vocal ability is. It's about the desire to sing together of God's infinite love and mercy. John Bell says “We sing because God commands us. The assembly is not a passive audience.”

We are SO lucky here at St. James to be a community that SINGS! Week after week I'm approached by visitors who are amazed by our singing community. Some people have never experienced that in their own churches. As St. Augustine says, “Singing is for the one who loves.” May we continue to be a community of Faith, Hope, and Love.

Someone is Watching and Wondering **CATECHESIS**

Catechetical formation is an essential part of initiation into the Catholic church, and the **primary** minister of initiation in the RCIA is the **parish community**. The quality of lives within the community, their concern and interest for one another, the manner of worship, the commitment to social justice and outreach activities, all of this is the where and how of the RCIA. People come to St. James to become part of our community. It is our responsibility not only to welcome them, but to show these interested individuals what makes our community distinctive, warm, involved, and a strong Catholic Christian community. Therefore, it is essential that each of us understand our responsibility in the adult initiation process.

Catechesis is an echoing of the gospel. It is a ministry of all the baptized who proclaim and live the good word of God's grace; salvation in Jesus Christ. It is a full and robust action that invites each person to respond in faith, embodying charity and justice and mercy. The full person is called and challenged through good catechesis.

Catechesis is concerned with helping the catechumen name their experiences of God, and reflect on their responses. Additionally, the catechumen needs to come to know the story of the Catholic community and how, throughout the centuries, we have come to name the experience of God in our midst. If the period of the precatechumenate was a time for storytelling, the period of the catechumenate develops that story into a dialogue. We don't abandon the storytelling and faith-sharing, but expand it to include the particular story of our Catholic faith, and our parish community.

Catechesis is not about passing information. It is about enlivening faith. How can we incorporate the great symbols of our community, including the rich word symbols of doctrine, to empower and enliven their faith? The exciting challenge of catechesis is to make the word of God, in scripture and as articulated in the faith of the community, credible and meaningful. This is not a watering down of the word of God, but rather a raising up of that word so that it has a bearing on our ordinary, daily life experiences.

Therefore, catechesis in the RCIA is designed for adults, who after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God. They begin the journey of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts, and leads them to the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. May each of us rejoice daily in God's good news. Inquirers please contact me at 816/522-3311.

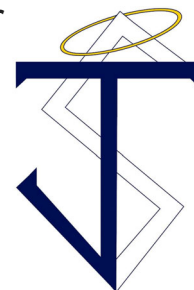
