Time: 7: 00pm

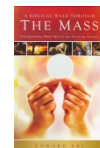
Cost: No charge for class - course workbook is \$20

Someone is Watching and Wondering



In two days we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, and once again hear proclamation of the Sermon on the Mount from Matthew's Gospel. I have struggled with this teaching of Jesus for a long time, especially the 2nd Beatitude: "Blessed (Happy) are they who mourn, for they will be comforted." This Wisdom of Pooh provided some food for thought.

A few days forward will mark the third anniversary of my husband Gene's earthly death, and although many have offered comfort I have discovered that mourning is both personal and singular. What I mean is that mourning a loss is unique for each individual and instance. For me, healing continues to come through baby steps which allow me to rediscover the depth of my trust in and love for God. However, I also know that mourning is not something which I do alone. Rather it is the actions of others, not their words, that bring me comfort and a sense of God's peaceful presence. Every day, friends and my St. James family continue to lead me in a renewal of life; refreshing my awareness of His loving embrace. These individuals allow me to express my feelings. They show empathy and compassion. They don't offer suggestions indicating it is time for me to move on, or criticism when I appear overwhelmed, frustrated and lost. They share my pain, offer comfort through prayer, offer a meal, spend time with me, and they listen. Through these ministers, whom I believe Jesus sends, I am beginning to understand the full rich meaning of the Communion of Saints. This communion includes the living, faith-filled followers of Jesus' teachings, who continue to bring His love to those who mourn, without question of age, race, religion, economic status, social position, education or worthiness. They shine the light of Christ into the emptiness resulting from loss. Although our journey of mourning requires walking through darkness, into a future that is unknown, a single small candle will light the way. It is His light in which we can trust.

I was in elementary school when my sister took me to see the movie Carousel. I remember being upset and sad at the conclusion. However, I found beauty in the words of this song which has stuck with me all these years: "When you walk through a storm, hold your head up high, and don't be afraid of the dark. At the end of the storm there's a golden sky and the sweet silver song of the lark, Walk on through the wind, walk on through the rain though your dreams be tossed and blown. Walk on walk on with hope in your heart and you'll never walk alone." (From Carousel, *You'll Never Walk Alone*) As an adult Catholic I also realize that Easter is meaningless without Good Friday. If I give myself to Jesus, He will share my pain and suffering, just as He did on the cross. He will replace my loss with peace and hope as He did the first Easter morning. His love will fill me with joy. I believe when I've felt most abandoned by God, He sent one of His children to journey with me. He never leaves me or you alone.

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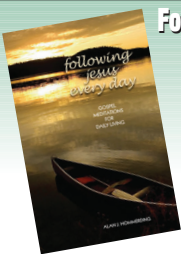
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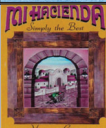


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
