From the Pastor's Pen

When Pope Francis visited Assisi, he offered a reflection on the power of forgiveness. "In this year of mercy, it becomes ever clearer the path of forgiveness can truly renew the church and the world," the Holy Father said. "To offer today's world the witness of mercy is a task from which none of us can feel exempted."

On Sunday, August 14, we dedicated the Reconciliation Labyrinth at Precious Blood Center as part of our province's response to this Holy Year of Mercy. We envision this sacred space on the grounds of the Center as a place where those who are carrying heavy burdens of guilt or grief, doubt or fear, resentment or remorse, can come to walk this sacred path as a way of finding forgiveness and peace in their lives. As Fr. Joe Nassal stated, "The labyrinth models for us how reconciliation is a journey toward the sacred center where we recognize ourselves and each person as a child of God. It is this reality of covenant relationship that shapes a spirituality of reconciliation."

This ancient symbol and spiritual exercise can help us and those who come to our center for prayer, reconciliation, and renewal find and expand that safe place inside our souls from which we can live as ministers of mercy.

A labyrinth slows one down in a maze of twists and turns until one reaches the center. There is no hurry. There is a beginning and an end. And in between, one walks in a circular design that seeks to take one deeper into the mystery of life, to that safe place within ourselves where we allow God to find us. And when God finds us, we can find each other.

As we come to the end of this Year of Mercy, we are still in need of reconciliation. It is more than just celebrating the sacrament; it is working with one another to settle differences – to come to the table together and be able to speak our truth and have a true dialogue.

As we approach Advent, where do we seek reconciliation today? What areas of our own life need healing? Are we willing to seek that healing today and let go of past hurts and move to a better place in life?

May we know God's mercy in our life today and in the world around us. My prayers are with you today.

Children's Choir

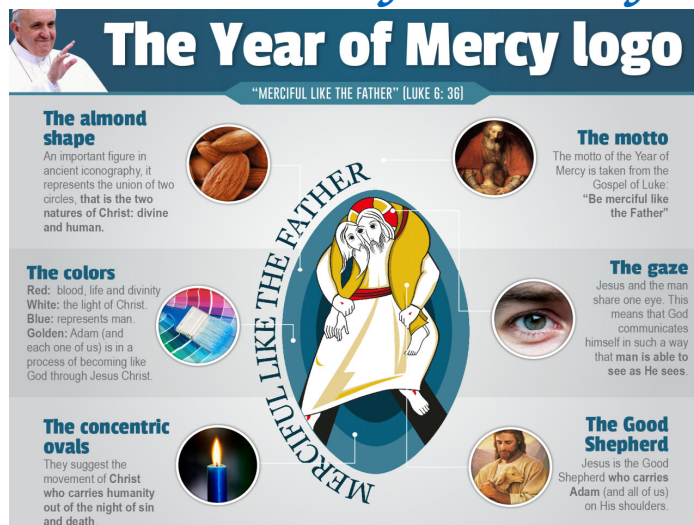

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Today, in anticipation of the new Liturgical Year which begins next Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King, and the closing of the Year of Mercy. Recently while searching the internet for information about mercy, I found this image from *Catholic Link* which explains the symbolism of the Mercy Logo. As many times as I've looked at this logo, I never picked up on the significance of the overall shape, nor did I recognize that Jesus and the man share an eye. As the Liturgical Year of Mercy ends, revisiting this image could be powerful.

First, the almond shape. As stated above this shape is the union of two concentric circles, which represents the unity of the two natures of Christ Jesus. We believe Jesus' humanity comes through His mother Mary, while His divinity makes Him totally one with God the Father, and the Spirit. For me, however, the almond shape also represents our baptismal unity with Jesus and with one another. God's grace is eternally present in our lives, leading and guiding us through difficult times and decisions. In the sacraments of baptism, confirmation, and Eucharist, we are renewed and strengthened with His spirit. The more we accept God's gifts, the more we open our lives to Him, the more complete is our unity. Remember, all things are possible through Christ.

Next, I focused on the shared eye. If God communicates such that I see as He sees, what does this say about my actions. Am I rejecting God when I refuse His lens of mercy? Do I have spiritual cataracts that cloud my vision? Am I so directed by my own wants and desires, that I forget the prayer Jesus taught, and which I pray daily: "Thy will be done. . .as we forgive others"? These are difficult questions, but if I believe His words, then I must also open my life to Him, embracing His love, and allowing His spirit to live in me.

Finally, the concentric blue ovals, which make up the background of the logo are a reminder that Christ will always bring us out of the darkness that at times seems to enclose our lives. His light, His grace, His love will not fail. God is love, and there are times when His presence seems to be the only constant in my life. I hope this logo will become a constant remainder of the true meaning of the Year of Mercy, that will continues to grow in each of our lives as we strive to do His will.

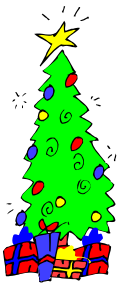

Your gift card will be ordered on Monday morning and placed in the envelope with your hand written Christmas wish.
