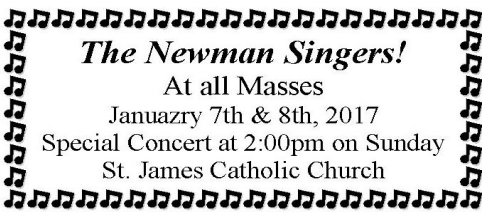

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Over the years I have come to realize the importance of human companionship. Anthropologically and biologically humans are considered “pack animals.” In other words, we are never meant to be alone and there is no other creature that is a substitute for human to human interactions. Although humans form close relationships with animals,

especially pets, these relationships do not fulfill the need for intimate friends and family. The second creation story in Genesis reveals God's infinite wisdom and love when He created Eve as a suitable partner for Adam. Although Adam was surrounded by all the goodness of God's creation, there was still a need and desire for someone like himself. Another human to share the wonders of life. Someone to talk to, to learn with, to experience human emotions. Another person to help solve problems, to create art, music and literature. Someone to explore the wonders of the universe, and help create endless possibilities from the imagination and ingenuity of their human mind. Someone to share laughter, hopes, and sorrows. Like Adam we need other humans to lift our spirits when we feel down. A unique person who listens to our pain and struggles. Someone who helps build traditions, who passes on the knowledge inherited from previous generations. Someone who is always prepared to lend a helping hand, carrying our burdens, defending our dignity, and offering simple kindness. Someone who “has our back.” I believe only human companionship can fulfill these needs which are vitally important to the well being of every individual.

For me what isn't important, however, is the color of skin, age, sex, culture, religion, or politics of the individuals who are my companions on this journey of life. It is the presence of the other person, his or her willingness to listen and not judge, to share ideas without forcing me to accept them. I need people who engage in respectful dialogue and who confront the challenges such dialogue elicits. People who accept me as I am and who acknowledge that we are each unique individuals, God's beloved children, made in His image and likeness, brought into life by His Spirit, cherished and protected by His love. As I reflect on the meaning of this third week of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, I realize that the greatest Joy in my life, next to His presence and love, is the human companionship I continue to experience. Yes, I enjoy quiet moments alone, but only in light of the knowledge that I am never totally alone. God continues to provide other humans, companions on my life journey, who bring and share His joy.
