From the Pastor's Pen

The month of May began with cloudy skies and rain. Monday, May 1st, we celebrated the feast of St. Joseph the Worker and this month of May is also dedicated to Mary, Mother of God. From the Catholic Encyclopedia, "The May devotion [to our Lady] in its present form originated at Rome where Fr. Latomia of the Roman College of the Society of Jesus, to counteract infidelity and immorality among the students, made a vow at the end of the eighteenth century to devote the month of May to Mary. From Rome, the practice spread to the other Jesuit colleges and thence to nearly every Catholic church of the Latin rite (Albers, "Bluethenkranze", IV, 531 sq.). This practice is the oldest instance of a devotion extending over an entire month." (Catholic Encyclopedia, "Special Devotions for Months")

Some may ask why the month of May? May is month of new beginnings, it is springtime, when Mother Earth comes alive with new life and blossoms. May also includes the celebration of Mother's Day – celebrating the women of our lives who bring new life into being.

Also during the month of May is World Day of Prayer for Vocations. This year May 7th, marks the 54th World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Pope Francis in his Papal message speaks of the missionary voice of vocations. "Now, on this 54th World Day of Prayer for Vocations, I would like to reflect on the missionary dimension of our Christian calling. Those who drawn by God's voice and determined to follow Jesus soon discover within themselves an irrepressible desire to bring the Good News to their brothers and sisters through proclamation and the service of charity. All Christians are called to be missionaries of the Gospel! As disciples, we do not receive the gift of God's love for our personal consolation, nor are we called to promote ourselves, or a business concern. We are simply men and women touched and transformed by the joy of God's love, who cannot keep this experience just to ourselves. For "the Gospel joy which enlivens the community of disciples is a missionary joy (Evangelii Gaudium, 21)."

We pray this day for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. We pray for men and women to have hearts and minds open to hearing God's call and finding within themselves the joy of sharing the Good News. It is a message that first touches each of our hearts and then in turn we are set on fire to share it with others.

As the rains continue to fall, may the sun shine once again to warm our hearts and to bring to life the beauty of nature. The blooms, the buds, the green blades of grass remind us that God is still present and very much alive in our lives. May the hope of a new day give us strength and inspiration.



Someone is Watching and Wondering



The scripture readings today, the Fourth Sunday of Easter, focus on discipleship. Many Christians refer to themselves as members of a church rather than disciples because they understand disciples as the twelve who spent intimate time with Jesus during His earthly ministry. Yet if we look at the etymology of the word "disciple," it is derived from the Greek word *mathetes* which literally means a learner. A disciple, therefore, is a person who directs his mind towards discovery, attaching him/herself to a teacher, and in the process becoming a follower, disciplined by his/her teachings toward a new way of living. As such, to call oneself a Christian literally means to be a disciple of Jesus.

This year, at the Easter Vigil we at St. James welcomed 11 + 2 new disciples of Christ through the sacrament of baptism. These individuals began their journey of formation many months ago and with the help of mentors/sponsors have entered into a new relationship, within the community of fellow Christians, with our teacher Jesus. Their journey continues, however, as they struggle with the everyday issues of living with one another. I like to think of the newly baptized as entering a period of apprenticeship, where formation and growth continues as they grow in faith, live sacramental lives and receive Jesus' body and blood regularly. (FYI, the + 2 are very young children who will also be lead in formation towards discipleship, and will at a later date receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.)

Sometimes it is with a heavy heart that during this time every year I am forced to ask myself the following question: "Am I still a disciple of Jesus?" It may seem a bit strange to ask this question, but in reality I know that my faith reaches places in my life where it seems to become stale. I go through the motions, but the excitement of discovery and new growth seems to be missing. Then, as though a flash of light explodes in my mind, I am reawakened to the meaning of discipleship. Yes, I come face to face with the fact that I too am still a student, learning the teachings of Jesus and how I am being called to follow Him. I am definitely still in formation, very much an apprentice myself. Although I believe I have grown spiritually, my growth is still undergoing the process of change and development. I still look to mentors, nurturing teachers, spiritual directors, and fellow seekers of wisdom and truth. I think it is safe to say we are all on individually unique pathways of discipleship. I also think it safe to say that although we don't know the direction our path will take, we know that a fuller life with Jesus is where our journey leads. Enjoy the journey fellow disciples!




