Someone is Watching and Wondering

For the past several weeks I have written about the RCIA and invited contacts through email, voice/text message (gene.gagnon@gmail.com) (816-522-3311), or to visit one of the Sunday morning sessions beginning at 10:20am in the St. Gaspar Room.



Another hat I wear is serving as the facilitator for the St. James Ministry of Caring/Healing. This is a ministry for sharing losses. It is a "Journey of Hope, Peace, Joy, and Love." As facilitator I function as a guide for anyone who has experienced or currently faces, a life-changing event such as illness, job uncertainty, death of a love one, divorce or other personal crisis-change. The focus of this ministry involves a confidential safe place for open sharing, perhaps experiencing the pain of fellow journeyers, and personal healing. Following are some of the tasks in the healing process that are examined:

ACCEPTING THE REALITY OF THE LOSS - Encouraging one another to talk about the loss can help each person understand, both emotionally and intellectually, that the loss has occurred; **ALLOWING YOURSELF TO EXPERIENCE THE PAIN OF GRIEF** - Each individual must accept the painful reality of their loss because, if pain is not allowed and encouraged to run its course, it will surface again and again; **ADJUSTING TO A DIFFERENT ENVIRONMENT** - You may not be aware of your changing role(s) since the loss. Learning new skills by performing necessary tasks helps assume increasing responsibility and acceptance of your new life; **RECOGNIZING A WITHDRAWAL OF EMOTIONAL ENERGY RESULTING FROM YOUR LOSS AND INVESTING IN NEWNESS OF LIFE** - You may work on this task for the remainder of your life. The support and encouragement of a loving community, however, will give you a strong incentive for forming new relationships, and developing new interests when you are ready.

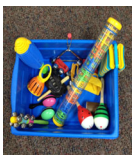
