From the Pastor's Pen

Welcome to the month of October designated as World Mission Month with World Mission on Sunday, October 22. Why devote an entire month to world missions? Because there is lots of work still to be done. World Mission Day is celebrated every year in every country wherever there are Catholics committed to building a better world for all of God's people, a world where everyone has all they need to live a dignified and fulfilling life. It is the day on which we reflect on the urgency to proclaim the Gospel in our times.

Also this month, on October 21 we, as Missionaries of the Precious Blood, will celebrate the Feast Day of our Founder, St. Gaspar Melchior Balthasar del Bufalo. St. Gaspar was born on the feast of the Epiphany, hence his name and founded the Society in 1815. The feast of a saint is generally celebrated on a date of significance in his or her life, e.g., the date of birth, death, canonization, etc. Gaspar's feast could not be celebrated on his birthday, January 6, because it is the Solemnity of the Epiphany. For the same reason it was not judged opportune to celebrate it on the date of his death, December 28, since the Feast of the Holy Innocents occurs on that date. At one point it was celebrated on July 15, (yippee my birth day) but Rome chose a different date of June 23, at which time the congregation sought to change the date to June 23. But since sometimes the feast of the Sacred Heart falls on June 23, St. Gaspar would get bumped and not celebrated. Then the date of January 2 or January 4 was chosen. When the decree was issued that no celebrations could be during the Octave of Christmas, once again Gaspar's feast day was bumped. In 1962, the congregation once again asked to have the date changed and moved to October 21. But still the question why that date? This was the date on which Gaspar preached in one of the first parish missions.

It may seem like only a day on the calendar, but when it comes to celebrating those special days in our lives, we all know what a difference that one day can make. And oh, October is also the month of Halloween. No way can we forget those ghosts and goblins, tricks and treats.

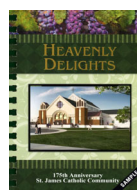

Someone is Watching and Wondering



The most recent architectural drawings for our new worship space were unveiled to us earlier this month, and the Ground Breaking date was announced for April 15, 2018. This announcement has generated much excitement and enthusiasm in our parish. I'm sure there are many opinions, changes and details yet to be addressed, but one thing that remains completely implanted in my brain is the words of a very wise woman. I was running off at the mouth about something bothering me in our Church. Like the sage she is she reminded me, “Sandy, you are the Church. Each of us are the Church, so perhaps the change needs to come from within you and I.”

As I was thinking about the joy of sharing Mass in our new space, once it is completed, I again realized the significance of her words. The Church is truly about the people. In fact, as I look at this picture of St. Peter's Basilica, my first impression of this image is more that of an official governmental building rather than a place of worship. My mental image of a church structure is much less grand and official. Yet the joy and reverence, the love of God seen on the faces of people standing in this great place as they listen to the words of Christ proclaimed in scripture and the message of Pope Francis when he addresses God's people is unmistakable. There is peace and hope here. The sense of belonging to something much greater than my own small world is not emitting from the structure, but rather from the voices raised in praise of His grace and giving glory to His name. The love felt is the knowledge that He is present among us, that He cares and forgives us. The joy does not come from the grandeur of the space, although one may feel awe at the beauty. The joy is found within when we realize that we are brothers and sisters in Christ and that He alone rises us to new levels of understanding, tolerance and love of one another.

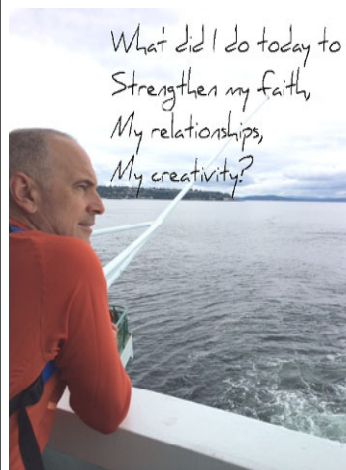

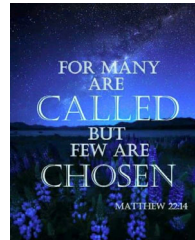

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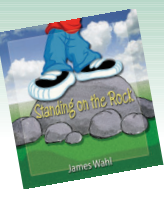


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
