## Do You Know?

Ground water pressure has forced water through the surface of portions of our parking lot and caused considerable damage.

In the next two weeks, weather permitting, we will attempt to alleviate ground water pressure through a series of "French Drains".

Contractors will bury approximately 360 feet of 6 inch perforated pipe to relieve pressure and move the water to the slit drain that runs parallel to the Palisade Road.

We will mill 1 1/2" of the asphalt (approximately 6,600 square feet) in the damaged area and refinish to code.

Top dress and restripe of the entire lot will tie into completion of the church.

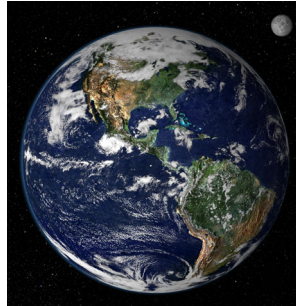

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



Last week I suggested that world peace begins with each of us, and I suggested that individual behavior towards one another truly matters. Today I wish to shift the focus to the natural world.

This week we celebrate Thanksgiving, a National Holiday instituted as a time to pause and remember our blessings. One blessing rarely mentioned, however, is God's gift of the Universe. I realize the Universe spans an enormous distance and, in fact, there is so much in space that we do not yet know or understand. However, we are all familiar with our planet, the "Third Rock from the Sun," Mother Earth. Our planet is truly filled with natural wonders: oceans, mountains, great grasslands, jungles, swamps, deserts, tundra, and the polar regions. Each ecosystem is composed of biotic and abiotic diversity, yielding food, great beauty, and yes changing climate and nature's fury. I never cease to be amazed at our planet. I have been fortunate to travel to all 50 states, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and more than 15 foreign countries. I have thoroughly enjoyed the culture and traditions, food, ethnicity, and history of these places. I am troubled, however, as a Catholic-scientist.

I have grave concerns for the life and health of our planet. Are we truly good stewards of all that God has given to us, or are we using the earth with its abundant resources for our own greed and selfish benefit? Change is inevitable, but rapid change brought about through misuse seems to be not only wasteful, but sinful. Human activities such as overuse of land, industrial and agriculture practices that pollute our waters, destruction of air quality through our reliance on fossil fuels, and over-harvesting of the oceans is not good stewardship. Wilderness areas that are destroyed for profit, rather than being conserved for future generations, demonstrates a lack of knowledge, foresight and responsible public policy. I am forced to ask, what are we leaving for future generations.

The story of creation presents a panoramic view of the world, and scripture reveals that God intended humanity to cooperate in the preservation and protection of our natural environment. Our planet was entrusted to us as a gift and legacy, for which we all share responsibility. As Pope Francis reminds us, our human dignity and welfare are deeply connected to our care for the whole of creation. As you gather with family and friends this week, take a moment to remember the blessing of the natural world in which we live.
