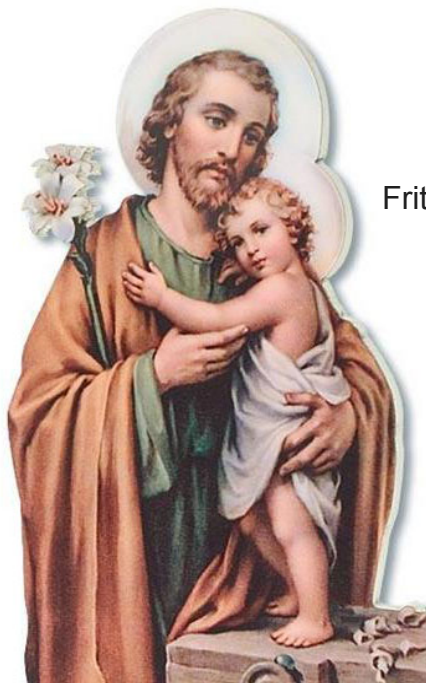

Everyone in the parish is invited to come, pray with us, and have dinner together.

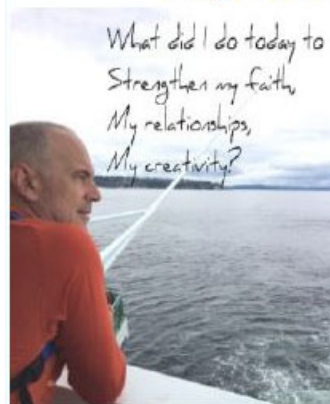

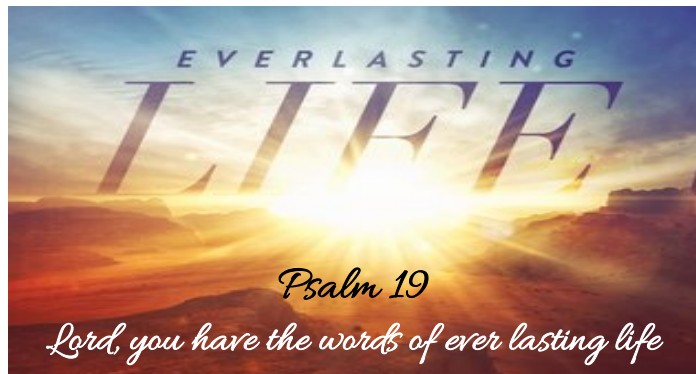

Reflection

The Lord's commandments are pure, holy, just, and good. By them we discover our need of a Savior; and then learn how to adorn his gospel. They are the means the Holy Spirit uses in enlightening the eyes; they bring us to a sight and sense of our sin and misery, and direct us in the way of duty. The fear of the Lord is clean, it will cleanse our way; and endures forever. The word of God, received by faith, is more precious than gold; it is sweet to the soul, sweeter than honey.

Someone is Watching and Wondering



Today we as a faith community celebrate together the First Scrutiny with our Elect. As part of their spiritual journey and final preparation for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil, these rites reflect our continuous self-searching and repentance. The focus is to "uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good. . .to deliver the Elect from the power of sin. . .to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ, who is the way, the truth, and the life." (*Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*, pg. 78) Upon reflecting on the scrutinies, which we celebrate over three successive Sundays, I was reminded of the communal dimension of our individual faith journeys, and of the resulting, deep, personal friendships I have discovered along the way.

There is a Celtic expression, *Anam Cara* which has helped me understand the deep, unending relationship between friends. *Anam Cara* is literally translated "Soul Friend." Celtic tradition affirms an *Anam Cara* as a teacher, companion or spiritual guide. With such a person we share our innermost self, reveal hidden intimacies of our life, mind, and heart. Such a friendship cuts across all convention, creating an act of recognition and belonging that joins souls in an ancient and eternal way. Everyone shares an integral human need for an *Anam Cara*. In such a relationship we stand without mask or pretention. We feel at safe, at home. With love as the threshold where the divine and human meet, we come to understand that love is the most real and creative form of human presence. Within such a love is a shared, a deeper awareness, and a mutual acceptance of one another. An awareness which brings integration and healing is one of the greatest gifts of an *Anam Cara* relationship. We are transformed; able to see and understand differently. An *Anam Cara* is one who awakens our life, and frees us to life's possibilities which we receive as pure grace from our loving Father. I think this is what Jesus offers to the Samaritan woman and all God's children; not only His love and friendship but the ability to form *Anam Cara* relationships; to become soul friends.

Today, along with our Elect, may we look within and discern where and how we need Jesus to help us become *Anam Cara*.

St. Joseph Table Cookie Recipes

Cookies of all kinds are needed for the St. Joseph Table on March 10 and 11. The ingredients for the Tay Tu's cookies were inadvertently left out of the recipe printed in last week's bulletin. The complete recipe is printed below as is a recipe for White Biscotta's.

Tay Tu's Cookies

5 cups Flour	1 tsp. Cinnamon
Pinch of Salt	1 1/4 cups Crisco
1 tsp. Baking Powder	4 Eggs
(rounded)	1 - 16 oz Hershey's syrup
1 tsp. Baking Soda	1 tsp. Vanilla
1/2 cup Sugar	1 cup Chopped Pecans
1 tsp. Cinnamon	1 tsp. Cloves

Beat eggs, add syrup to beaten eggs, add shortening and sugar. Mix dry ingredients together, add flour and nuts. Roll into small balls. Cook for 8 minutes at 375 degrees on ungreased cookie sheet. Cool completely. Ice with cookie icing.

Cookie Icing Recipe

1 bag powder sugar 1 tsp. Vanilla
1/2 stick of Butter (melted)
Add warm milk slowly. About 1/3 of cup to powder sugar, vanilla, and butter until slightly thickened. Ice cookies. When completely dry put in tins or plastic containers.

White Biscotta Recipe

1 cup Sugar	5 cups Flour
1/2 cup Crisco	5 tsp. Baking Powder
1 stick margarine	1/3 tsp. Baking Soda
4 eggs	1 1/2 tsp. Vanilla

Cream sugar, margarine and Crisco until fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time. Beat well. Add sifted dry ingredients to creamed mixture. Lastly, add milk and mix well.

Roll into 2 1/2 inch length finger shapes. Bake on lightly greased cookie sheet at 400 degrees for 8 to 10 minutes. Remove from oven; bottoms will be white. Ice with cookie icing (see recipe above).

St. Joseph Table committee members will be baking cookies in the Social Hall on Monday and Tuesday, March 5 and 6 from 9am - 8pm. And on Wednesday, March 7 from 9am - 1pm. If you like to bake cookies and have the time, please join us and help.
