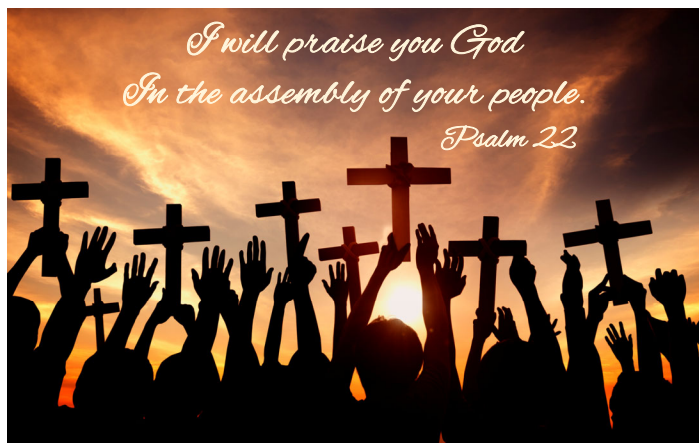

As most of you know, in January 2017, I was diagnosed with NASH and Stage III liver disease. Due to the rapid deterioration of my liver, it was decided my best chance was to have a liver transplant and was put on the transplant list at KU Med.

At about 11pm on Tuesday, April 17, I received the phone call from KU Med telling me that they had a liver for me and to get there immediately.

The next day I underwent the transplant process and am happy to let you know that the surgery was successful and I'm doing well. As I write this, I am still in the hospital but hopefully I'll be home by the time you read this.

Thank you for all your prayers; I feel them every day. Your outpouring of love and concern in your cards and calls blesses me greatly.

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



A week ago I read an article by Fr. Ron Rolheiser, OMI, titled "Love is coming home". This article got me to thinking about what love and coming home mean to me. Of course I was drawn to my early childhood and walking home from school. There were many times when I made this journey alone as I would stay after school to help my teacher or to go to a Girl Scout meeting. I felt safe in my neighborhood and actually enjoyed the sights and sounds, especially of the changing seasons. I also knew that I had a home and there was usually my mom or sister waiting for my arrival. Jumping ahead to 1973 when my husband and I returned to Kansas City after living in Germany for four years. We were both excited to see our families again but also slightly anxious as we were returning with two children who would be meeting grandparents, aunts, uncles, and cousins for the first time. The memory on which I reflected the longest, however, was my coming home to God.

There was a period of approximately 14 years when I felt shut off from God and the Church. It wasn't that I stopped believing that God is real, or that I didn't feel His presence in the wonders of nature. Rather, I think, it was a time when I felt I could make it on my own and didn't need the constant reminders of my mistakes, shortcomings, and failures. I was also very, very busy, or so I thought, and there just wasn't time. I was completing college, raising three children, going to school functions, and trying to be a wife. Gradually I began to realize that something was missing, although I couldn't name that something. Long story short, I cajoled some of my friends to attending midnight Mass, at the Cathedral, with Bishop Boland presiding, December 24, 1993 and my life changed. I was hungry for a new relationship with God and with other Christians. I was hungry for a community where I felt welcome. Although I did not realize it at that time, I needed to *go home*.

Since that time much has happened in my life. I fell in love with Jesus, I found a community at St. James, I learned to trust others, and I learned to love without expectations or conditions. Every time I think of my St. James family, whenever I walk through the Parish door, I feel I have come home.

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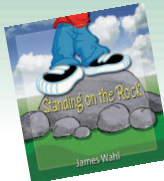
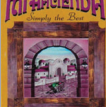
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
