### Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord Monday, August 6



The feast of the Transfiguration of Christ celebrates the revelation of Christ's divine glory on Mount Tabor. After revealing to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem, Christ, along with Sts. Peter, James, and John, went up the mountain. There, Saint Matthew writes, "he was transfigured before them. And his face did shine as the sun: and his garments became white as snow."

For Peter, James, and John, it was also a glimpse of the glories of heaven and of the resurrected body promised to all Christians. As Christ was transfigured, two others appeared with Him: Moses, representing the Old Testament Law, and Elijah, representing the prophets. Thus Christ, Who stood between the two and spoke with them, appeared to the disciples as the fulfillment of both the Law and the prophets.

At Christ's baptism in the Jordan, the voice of God the Father was heard to proclaim that "This is my beloved Son". During the Transfiguration, God the Father pronounced the same words.

### Children's Choir



**Parent Comment:** My child does not sit still during Mass, so he shouldn't be in Children's Choir.

**Miss Lori's Response:** Children's Choir is the perfect place for a wiggly child. The children have a great view

of everything that's going on in the church, so they are much more engaged - leading to better behavior during Mass.

Children's Choir is open to all children in Kindergarten through 8th Grades with no fees and no auditions. Children K-5 make up the bulk of our choir, and we invite 6th-8th graders to be cantors-in-training, to bring harmony to our choir, and to serve as youth helpers when necessary. We practice most Saturdays at 10am, and we typically lead the music at the 11am Mass on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of each month, as well as on Christmas and Easter, and various other feast days.

Practices begin August 18, and our first Mass is September 16. Children's Choir registrations are available in the Narthex after all Masses this weekend, and are also available online. Contact Lori Tajchman with questions.

### Someone is Watching and Wondering

**METANOIA** Life-long conversion is grace, pure gift from God. The Greek work *metanoia* "to turn and see again" describes both "conversion" and "repentance". It conveys the idea of understanding old ideas with a fresh mind, clearer eyes, and an open heart. Becoming a Catholic is a process of *metanoia* requiring preparatory steps and support of a faith community open to its own on-going conversion.

**The first** step is a willingness to live with ambiguity; moving from "life is a problem to be solved" to "life is a mystery that unfolds." **Second** is a life grounded in attentive prayer, listening to the small voice within. Not a meaninglessly recitation of prayers, but a commitment to daily prayer that invites holiness into our day; experiencing the wonder of life. **Third** is a commitment to community. It is trendy to speak of being "spiritual but not religious." Such spirituality is an illusion. Community tests our spiritual growth and conviction to follow Christ. Without community we live un-confronted lives. We cannot profess to be Catholic pretending God is far away in some spiritual realm. He is present among us. How we treat one another is truly how we love and serve God.

**Fourth** is naming sin and repenting. A healthy realization of sin and how to repent from life patterns that bring pain to our human family is essential for conversion. Do I recognize my fault; am I willing to change; can I stop blaming others?

**Fifth** is seeking silence. Our culture is full of business. We need an inner place of simply being, remembering we are created in God's image. Silence and resting in God leads to the path of holiness. **Six** is service. More than just another task added to our hectic lives, service is a mental attitude: Do I consciously put the needs of others before my own, try to understand their behavior, show compassion and empathy? **Seven** is letting go of false idols. Where do I seek security: in nationalism, social standing, reputation, ideas, wealth, self-image? **Eighth** is our community's symbols and rituals. Do I experience deeper communion with God through the rites of the church? Am I aware of God's presence and call? **Ninth** is faithfulness and obedience. Obedience is not blind acquiescence to higher authority, but rather living with a deep humility, embracing our humanity. Faithfulness is consenting to remain in situations that are demanding or difficult. Although we must evaluate when circumstances become too overwhelming, most of us recognize that we grow spiritually, when we make it through the tough times. **Tenth** is discipleship and friendship with Christ. Understanding the Gospel with new insight reveals what Jesus is asking. Being challenged by the vision Jesus gives renewed purpose and meaning to our lives..

Life-long conversion is a grand invitation to the ups and downs of life, and we respond to God's call by falling more deeply and passionately in love with Jesus. There are two cornerstones to our Catholicism. The first is a way of life based on the incarnation, and Jesus' teaching that the meaning of life is found through love of God and neighbor. The second is a constant vision of life and the created universe which emphasizes God's presence in the world that finds God's glory in countless everyday, ordinary events. God relates to us in personal, unconditional, passionate, and absolutely reliable love. Our call to conversion is a call to live this love.

The Migrant Farm Workers Assistance Fund has a wish list of items that they distribute to the families while they are here. We will be taking up a collection of a few things on their list and would be grateful for any donations.

First on the list were hygiene kits, packed into a gallon Ziploc baggie including:

Full size bath soap bar	Full size shampoo
Skin lotion	Deodorant
Wash cloth & hand towel	2 disposable razors
Comb or brush	

You can tie or rubber band the bag to the washcloth and towel if they won't all fit.

We will also be collecting children's books – new and gently used. Books for all ages including (new) coloring books and crayons are welcome. So if your children have outgrown some of their books, we'd be happy to pass them along to new readers! They can also use activity workbooks, Spanish/English dictionaries, ACT/SAT/GED study books....pretty much anything a child or teen would like to read.

You can drop these items off at the RE office in the narthex, or bring them to the registration table. We'll be collecting all through the month of August.

We thank you for your generosity to these families who have so little. Just as a reminder, as this can be a sensitive subject, the migrant farm workers are here in this country legally and are a vital part of our agriculture system. Their lives are very difficult, especially for the children. The work is hard, the living conditions are spartan, and they are on the move constantly, so education is hit and miss. Any small kindnesses that we can offer them are very gratefully accepted.
