## From the Pastor's Pen

"Let us serve God with holy joy." ~ St. Gaspar del Bufalo

This weekend marks the beginning of National Vocation Awareness Week (Nov 4-10), an annual week-long celebration promoting vocations to the priesthood and religious life. As baptized, we are each called upon to recognize God's call in our lives to a vocation and ministry. What great joy do we find in living God's call and ministering to one another? A vocation to religious life begins in prayer and recognizing the gifts God has shared with each of us. Our response is how to use those gifts for the good of God and others. Today's responsorial psalm is "I love you, Lord, my strength." These words remind us of the one who first loved us and what is our response in return.

Mike and I are happy to tend to those who are sick or hurting, preparing for surgery, or coming to the end of their earthly journey. We welcome and invite your calls and request for a visit or to share the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. However, we need your help. Due to privacy issues and HIPPA laws, care facilities and hospitals are not allowed to give us patient information directly unless the patient or family member instructs them to do so or you or your family call us. So please, if you or a loved one is in need of a pastoral visit, please contact us and we will do our best to tend to your needs.

And now, for your prayers. I am hopefully in Buffalo, NY, this weekend for NRVC Vocation Directors Conference. I will be with 300 other vocation directors from religious communities across the world. I hope I'm enjoying the weekend and not stuck in a snow storm somewhere.

#### **H.O.P.E. / SCRIP GIFT CARD NEWS**

##### ***The Hidden Value***



Did you realize that the total worth of each H.O.P.E. Gift card you buy is actually greater than its face value?

St. James purchases the cards (called scrip) at a discount, ranging from a low of 1.50% to a high of 20%, and sells them to you at their face value.

Since “Ya Gotta Eat”, let’s take a look at the real value of some local merchant’s cards.

For example, a \$100 HyVee, Price Chopper or Sprouts card, purchased by St. James at a 5% discount, is actually worth \$105.00 when you buy it – \$100 for you and \$5.00 for St. James. \$25 and \$50 cards are also available at these stores; earning St. James 1.25 and \$2.50, respectively.

When eating out, keep in mind that a \$10 Dairy Queen card that St. James purchases at a 10% discount is worth \$11 – \$10 for you and \$1.00 for St. James. Other local restaurants that contribute significant percentages for every card purchased include Dickeys at 15% and Pizza Shoppe, The Land- ing, and Rancho Grande at 20%.

Think about it! St. James earns money for every HOPE Gift Card you purchase - to put this in “food” language: you can have your cake and St. James can eat it too.

Think about all of the places you shop each week and how much St. James could receive if you used HOPE Gift Cards to buy groceries and restaurant meals and well as cards for other purchases. And it won’t cost you a penny more!




