



### Children's Choir

#### Learning about Mass

 A bonus of participating in Children's Choir is being made aware of what is happening in the Mass, and recognizing the order of Mass. The children are becoming more aware of the appropriate times to stand, sit and kneel. They know when the Old and New Testaments are read, and they know what immediately follows. As we begin our journey into a new Liturgical season, the children will be anticipating the color changes coming with the Advent season. Do you know what color is coming?

## Someone is Watching and Wondering



The branches of the trees are now bare as the leaves lay on the ground and swirl on the sidewalks and streets. Snow has fallen for the first time this season. The days are shorter, the temperature lower, the air seems to have a crispness, the stars of the night sky seem brighter and more brilliant, and next Sunday we begin counting and waiting once again. I'm sure you already know, next Sunday ushers in a new liturgical year and we celebrate the first week of Advent, a time for hope. In anticipation of lighting the first candle of our Advent wreath, I have began my *Jesse Tree* with its symbols and stories.

I hope you are familiar with this tradition and will have a Jesse Tree in your home as a reminder of many of our faith traditions which point the way to Jesus. Take a few moments and recall a story for each symbol on the Jesse Tree above. Perhaps you need to refresh or add new symbols to your tree. In anticipation of what is to come, you may wish to share your faith with family and friends by explaining the tree you create.

Some of my favorite symbols are a sheaf of wheat to represent Ruth, a jar of oil for Samuel, a little cake for Elijah, a plough for Isaiah, a bear for Elisha (a reminder to curb my temper), and a tablet and stylus for Zechariah. Other symbols that are perhaps more common and obvious are a sling-shot, harp or crown for David, pillars for Solomon's temple, an apple for Adam and Eve, a rainbow for God's promise to Noah, a lion for Daniel, a dove for the Holy Spirit, a hammer and chisel for Joseph, a rose for Mary, and of course a baby in a manger for Jesus. There are so many others to choose for your tree, be creative. Our faith tradition is rich and diverse and remembering or re-reading the stories is a wonderful way to begin Advent. Of course this little Jesse Tree clearly points toward Christmas, but isn't Jesus what we are all waiting for. I'm not suggesting just a celebration of His birth, rather a celebration of renewal as we open our hearts, our minds, our lives to His presence and as we await for the time when He greets us, face to face.

HOPE Gift Cards are just the thing !

It's not too early to make your Christmas list and order the cards you need, especially if you plan to buy a large number.

By ordering your cards soon, you'll be assured that all of the HOPE Gift Cards you want will be available for you to pick up in plenty of time for Christmas giving.

Because we must pay for the cards when we order them, the number of gift cards we keep in our inventory is based on what we can reasonably expect to sell based on past sales. So, if you wait until the last minute to buy your cards, know that the cards you want might not be available because we are sold out. Last year a parishioner came into the parish office a week before Christmas to buy cards for all of his employees. Unfortunately, he was disappointed to learn that cards he wanted were "out of stock" and it was too late to order them for delivery before Christmas.

The moral of this story is "DON'T WAIT"! To avoid disappointment, order HOPE Gift Cards for Christmas giving very soon.

These pink cards can be found in the narthex on the wooded information stand. Everyone is asked to fill out a pledge to the Stewardship of Treasure (left side of card), in the past known as tithe. This is a calendar year pledge, so folks have not filled a 2019 card out before now.

The right side of the pink pledge card is for the NCF. If you already made the commitment for 2019, then nothing is required, you may leave it blank. If you have not pledged to 2019, we ask you to prayerfully consider doing so. We only have about half of the monies needed for our New Church building and we will continue to raise funds to assist with the loan.

If you currently use the ACH program, you may indicate that on the card and only sign on the line. (NO additional check information is required.) This would apply for either pledge, Stewardship of Treasure or NCF. If you would like to start using this method, sign and provide a voided check. NOTE: The ACH program is a ONCE A MONTH draw, on the first Wednesday. of the month.




