## Healing Our Family

Tending wounds and accompanying hearts to freedom in Christ

- As a response to both the abuse scandal in the Church and other sufferings that people bear, we will establish “Journey to Bethany,” a healing center within the diocese to address a variety of wounds and broaden awareness of healing resources by March 2020.
- Implement *The Light Is On For You* throughout the diocese in Lent 2019.

## Using Resources Wisely

Aligning God’s gifts for the Church’s life and mission

- Implement gift and charism programs throughout the diocese to activate Catholics for service and mission by Pentecost 2020.
- Create a comprehensive resource strategy by October 2021.
- Establish a retreat center/camp facility within the diocese by May 2022.

## Growing God’s Family

Activating our baptismal call to holiness and being disciple-makers

- Implement “Clear Path for Discipleship” \* and hold a diocesan conference by October 2020 to equip all parishes to create a culture of discipleship.
- Craft a comprehensive Youth to Young Adult Initiative (including an earlier age for the reception of Confirmation) by November 2022.

*\* The Clear Path for Discipleship is a process to help parish leaders form a plan to address the needs of people at every stage of faith development and to form missionary disciples. It will include a combination of workshops, leadership development, consulting and resource training to equip parishes for effective evangelization.*
