

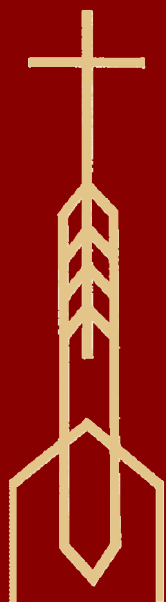

Reflection

We come to the end of the Easter season and we are given a mission. After being formed anew in the life and light of Jesus' death and resurrection we are to go forth as Jesus did in his ministry. Jesus sends us out into the world to be with people. To feed the hungry, comfort the outcast, touch the sick and lame, and everywhere proclaim the redemptive love of God. "As the father has sent me, so I send you."

In the readings today there are many allusions to the first two chapters of Genesis and the creation of the world. It is no surprise then that our psalm today speaks of creation too: "When you send forth your spirit they are created, / and you renew the face of the earth." The God of creation continues to create. Where do you notice the creative and renewing work of God in your own life? Where is the Spirit at work within you?

Someone is Watching and Wondering



In the Nicene Creed we profess to "believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord the giver of life" which aligns with the traditional Jewish understanding of God's Spirit as the creative and life-giving energy of Yahweh, as well as the power of God that came to rest on judges, kings, and prophets who were anointed to guide and challenge God's people. The spirit of Yahweh (God), therefore, His presence at work in the lives of every individual and, in fact, His presence at work in all creation. I try to impart this understanding to participants in the RCIA yet I wonder how the Holy Spirit is present in my ordinary, everyday life.

The Holy Spirit did not appear for the first time at Pentecost, but is mentioned in all four gospels. Luke notes, for example, that John the Baptist was "filled with the Holy Spirit," that the Holy Spirit came upon Mary, and that the Holy Spirit descended on Jesus at His baptism. Jesus proclaimed that the Father would "give the Spirit to those who ask him," and that the disciples should baptize in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." Acts presents the Holy Spirit as the life principle of the early church and reference to the Holy Spirit is central to the Pauline Letters; for Paul, imitation of Christ requires being open to the Spirit, receiving gifts of the Spirit, and living in the Spirit.

When I read accounts of the Apostles, Paul, and the early disciples, God's life force is evident in their work spreading Jesus' good news. Likewise, there are many examples in the lives of contemporary people such as Dr. Martin Luther King, Dorothy Day, Caesar Chavez, Nelson Mandela, Ester John, Josephine Bakhita, Desmond Tutu, and Edith Stein, to name just a few. I don't, however, see myself among these individuals and I continue to wonder how the Holy Spirit is my life force. I can only hope that at least some of my interactions with other people are guided by the Spirit. There are times when I offer words of encouragement, sympathy, or knowledge that come from deep within my heart, rather than my mind. At those times I believe the Spirit of God is working through me. There are also times when alone and feeling down that I feel His presence, peace, and life-giving energy urging me to go forward in love.

As I have said many times, we continue to be vigilant on spending.

Hillcrest Hope Donations

What do they do with it and why should I give them my stuff?

So you've cleaned out your basement and you need to dispose of your no-longer-needed items and you're looking for a good place for them to go. Perhaps they are still fairly new, maybe they were expensive when you purchased them, or there's some sentimental value to them and you hesitate to send them to a thrift store. But what if the store in question was not just a shop, but also a ministry? What if all the people who worked in that store volunteered their time so that they could help others in need?



That's the case with the Hillcrest Thrift store across from Franklin Elementary at 7 West Mill Street. Ryan, the manager, does a great job of promoting the store (especially via social media – check out their Facebook posts if you need a chuckle) as well as meeting the needs of those who need our help. For example, being in such close proximity to the jail, often folks who have been incarcerated make the thrift store their first stop upon release. If they were sentenced in the summer, and served their sentence, they might be released in the winter and their summertime clothing is not going to cut it. Ryan makes sure that they have warm clothing to go home in. It's hard to make a fresh start if you are shivering; you can't go to a job interview in shorts. The Hillcrest staff are the hands and human face of Jesus to all who are in need.

So let's say you have furniture to donate – the thrift store will take it, and they may even be able to come to your house and pick it up. If they have an apartment in need of an upgrade, the apartments get first pick. If they have a graduate of the program who is moving out into transitional housing or to totally independent housing, they also get to pick from what's available. All the rest goes on the sales floor for purchase by the general public and the proceeds that they make from that donated furniture go directly to underwrite the costs of the apartments. So Aunt Josephine's lovely end table will not only find a new forever home, but it will also help an at-risk family find their feet again. And that's a lot for a lowly end table to accomplish!

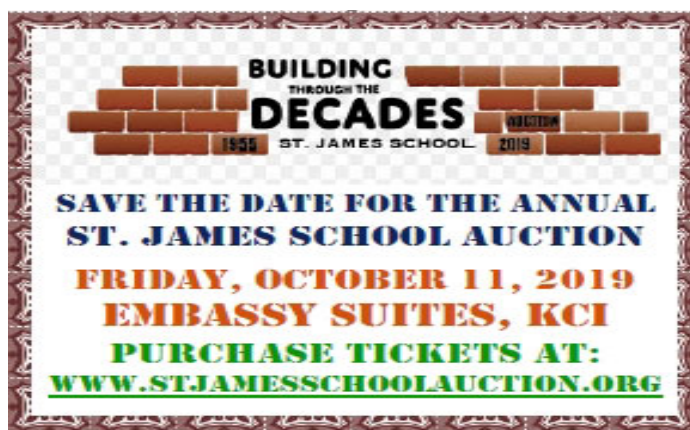

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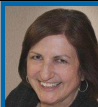
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
