Blue Line / Red Curbs

SCHOOL IS BACK IN SESSION

Please Observe These Parking Limitations:

The **Blue Line** across the parking lot defines limits on parking when school is in session. When parking in the parking lot, please observe the following:

- (a) If parking all day, park **North of the Blue Line**.
- (b) Cars parking **South of the Blue Line** must be moved by 2:00pm to allow pick-up of the school children.

The **Red Curbs** designate Fire Lanes. Please continue to observe the No Parking restrictions along the red curbs in front of the church and school.

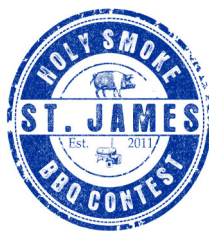

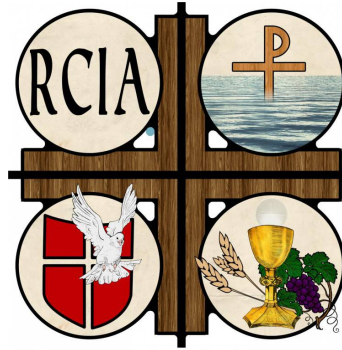

Someone is Watching and Wondering



As you can see from these symbols the RCIA journey is about preparing for and receiving the Sacraments of Initiation, i.e. Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Although we examine all seven of the Great Sacraments of the Church, the emphasis of the Rite of Christian Initiation of

Adults is directed toward the unbaptized and their journey to living as members of the "Body of Christ." Bill Huebsch in his book *Rethinking Sacraments* explains that "being in Christ means caring for one another without counting the cost; listening to ourselves and accepting the truth we find there; reflecting and praying often, alone and with others; giving good news and food to the poor; proclaiming release to captives; recovery of sight to the blind; freedom to those bound in themselves, and proclaiming Jesus as Lord." Thus, new life for the unbaptized begins with baptism.

For adults, baptism marks the end of their initial journey, discovering and developing faith in Christ and the beginning of another journey, making a solemn vow to remain faithful for life. In the early church, baptism was preceded by years of study, learning to turn one's life over to God, knowing Sacred Scripture, and taking on a ministry in the name of Christ. This was and remains a serious journey, a life changing conversion to live according to the Gospel, to love and serve God and one another. Such a journey requires a community to assist each individual in developing and understanding the covenant into which they wish to enter, embracing the sacramental life in all its infinite forms, discovering each unique call to ministry, and forming a life of communal and personal prayer.

To fully appreciate the role of the community in adult baptism, perhaps it will help to revisit the role of this parish community in infant Baptist. Simply stated the role of all the baptized is to raise the child in a community committed to Christ, thereby recognizing that each member of Christ's church is the bearer and teacher of the faith to every child through both word and actions in our everyday lives. With such a vision it would seem logical that the role of our Christian faith community for every adult who is on a journey towards baptism through the RCIA, is to be bearers and teachers of the Gospel message of Jesus through everyday words and actions. I believe this is a sacred obligation for each of us, not necessarily an easy task in our world and culture today. I solemnly ask you, therefore, to be part of their journey.

St. James Catholic School has openings for part-time childcare workers in our after school care program for children in preschool - 8th grades

The St. James School Aftercare Program is open from 3:00 - 6:00pm on school days, with occasional half days (Noon - 6:00pm) and occasional full days (7:00am - 6:00pm). Staff members are typically scheduled for 10 – 15 hours per week. We strive to keep a balance of male and female staff, to maintain safe environment guidelines.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, enjoy working with children, and able to complete diocesan requirements for safe environment training, including a background check. The position is typically a good fit for college students, especially education or nursing majors. Aftercare staff members work as a team, actively supervising 50 – 80 children daily, including snack time, playtime, and assistance with homework.

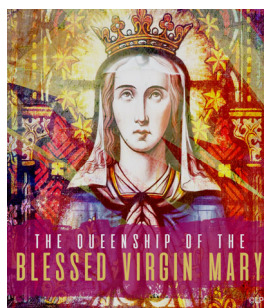

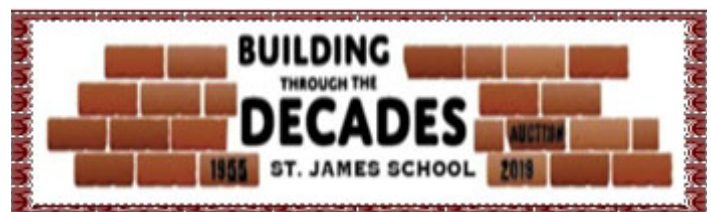
