## From the Pastor's Pen

In these last few days before Christmas, I am sure that the attention of most people is on final preparations: the decorations all in place; the welcome of visitors or plans to travel; last-minute shopping and wrapping of gifts; food preparation; perhaps a trip around the city to see the lights. In the midst of all this busyness, the Church asks us to give some time to spiritual preparation, especially reflecting on the Word of God.

At the Masses this weekend we hear a prophecy of Isaiah from a time about six centuries before the birth of Christ. He prophesies that a virgin shall conceive and give birth to a son, who will be called "Immanuel," meaning "God with us." Isaiah says that this will be a sign. What is the sign pointing to? That God will bring about a new age, the coming of the Messiah. The Advent hope is that we recognize that sign among us, not just the historical coming of Jesus in Israel, but the coming of Jesus in our personal lives and in our families today. In these last days of Advent the Church asks us: "Are you ready to reaffirm and live by that sign in your life? Will you make ready your heart to embrace His presence with you today?"

The passage from the gospel of Matthew gives us the account about another kind of preparation, focusing especially on the role of Joseph. Mary is pregnant. Joseph knows that the child is not his. How should he react? Through the message of God in a dream Joseph learns that Mary is with child by the power of the Holy Spirit. He embraces this message with total faith and obedience and takes Mary as his wife. There is an Advent message here for all of us. We, too, make an act of faith together with Joseph, believing that Jesus comes to us as God's special gift. In our final days of Advent preparation, we let the gifts we exchange with loved ones be an expression of our own reception of the greatest gift of all, Christ Jesus our Lord. We also see in all the people we encounter, God's gift.

As we celebrate the liturgies of Christmas, Fr. Mike and I recognize each of you as a gift to the parish, to the Church, and to the community. We are most grateful for all the ways that you are good stewards of your time, your talents, and your treasure. In all of these ways you are gift-givers, not just at Christmas but throughout the whole year. May you and your families be blessed and share in all the joys of this holy season.

Please know that my prayers are with you each day.

### Someone is Watching and Wondering



Today all the Advent candles are finally lit on the wreath, only the center candle awaits the celebration of His birth. Today, as throughout this season I find myself once again asking "Am I still watching and waiting for the Messiah," or have my thoughts turned to the

business of preparing for family celebrations, decorating, and gift giving? Have I left Jesus outside and abandoned all the preparations I made during Advent to open myself to Him honestly and completely?

Looking back over the past four weeks, I realize that my entire life, or at least most of it, has been a preparation to learn to trust Him and accept His love. This has required forgetting the idea that I must somehow earn God's love. I suppose the idea that "there is no such thing as a free lunch" is deeply engrained into my understanding of life. In truth it has always been easier for me to give to others than to accept anything given to me. I know what it is to love, but I have difficulty accepting love. Always the idea of betrayal is in the back of my mind. When things are going good, I tend to wait for the other shoe to fall. Again I refer to my control issues. I know I can neither predict or control anyone's actions but my own, but that is not easy for me to do. I don't think I'm a pessimist but I do sometimes run short on optimism and patience.

In these last days of Advent, as we approach Christmas, I know and believe in the very center of my being, that God's love for me is unconditional. I also know there are times when He is disappointed in me; I sense and feel that disappointment. I also know, however, that He is waiting for me to seek Him and ask forgiveness. When that happens, I know He will open another new door for me to enter and that His light will guide me through whatever lies ahead. Perhaps that knowledge is the true gift of all the waiting and watching of Advent. I am not a very touchy, feely person. I value knowledge and instinct and am not afraid to envision new ways of thinking and acting. I think the season of Advent provides a time for me to broaden my perspective, become more accepting of other people, and recognizing that we are all God's beloved children. Advent provides a quiet and simple message of letting go and letting God into my life. I know this is not an easy task for me but I also know that I need the Advent Season as a reminder to do just that. Yes, I continue to wait and watch for the opportunities He places before me to love and serve Him and my fellow brother and sisters. I'm a work in progress.

In closing, I wish each of you a Very Merry Christmas, and challenge you to keep watching for Him in your life.

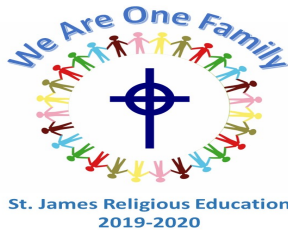
